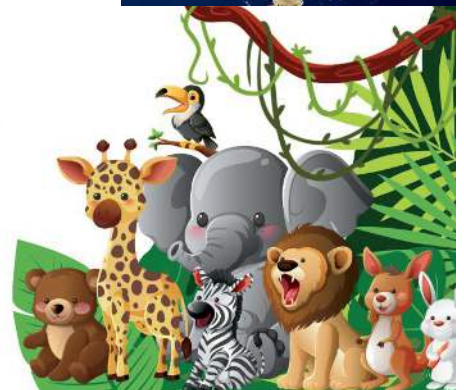

# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



## THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST 6 Things Roman Catholics Should Avoid During Holy Mass & How to Best Prepare to Receive the Holy Eucharist

The Eucharist is "the source and summit of the Christian life." "The other sacraments, and indeed all ecclesiastical ministries and works of the apostolate, are bound up with the Eucharist and are oriented toward it. For in the blessed Eucharist is contained the whole spiritual good of the Church, namely Christ himself, our Pasch." (CCC 1324)

The Holy Mass is the heart of the Catholic faith—a sacred encounter where Heaven meets Earth. It is far more than a weekly routine or a simple gathering. In every Mass, Christ's sacrifice on Calvary is made present once again. Because of this, Catholics are called to approach the liturgy with reverence, attention, and love. Yet sometimes, through habit or distraction, we can lose sight of the holiness of the moment. Here are some things Catholics should avoid during Mass to help preserve its sacredness:

### 1) Coming Late or Leaving Too Soon:

Mass is not only about receiving Holy Communion. Every part of the liturgy matters, from the opening prayers to the final blessing. Whenever possible, arrive early and remain until the Mass ends as a sign of reverence for God. Remember the words of Jesus "Could you not watch with me one hour? (Matthew 26:40)

### 2) Using Phones During the Liturgy:

Checking messages or scrolling through your phone can take your focus away from prayer. Silence your phone and set aside distractions so you can be fully present with the Lord. Gently redirect your focus to God without dwelling on the wandering thoughts. Treat every gentle refocus as a victory over habit.

### 3) Dressing Without Reverence:

The Church may not require formal attire, but modest and respectful clothing reflects the sacredness of being in God's house. The way we dress can show honor for the Eucharist. St. Paul reminds us that we are "Ambassadors of Christ"—we represent the Lord of Lords and the King of Kings. Therefore, let us always recognize both our dignity and our eternal destiny. We want to reflect the beauty of God in our outward attire and recognize that our destiny is the eternal glory and beauty of our heavenly reward.

### 4) Talking During Mass:

Whispering or unnecessary conversations can distract others who are praying. A spirit of silence helps create an atmosphere of worship, reflection, and reverence. Let us maintain "Sacred Silence". As psalmist says, "Be still and know that I am God". (Psalm 46:10)

### 5) Refusing to Participate:

In sports there are benchwarmers, the 2nd- or 3rd-string players who participate only to a limited degree. There are many Catholics in that same category. They may be present at Holy Mass physically, but they aren't there mentally and spiritually distracted, using their phone, thinking about lunch, wandering eyes. The Second Vatican Council, in *Sacrosanctum Concilium*, states that in Mass "all should participate fully, actively and consciously" in this greatest and most sublime of liturgical prayers. The angelic Doctor, St. Thomas Aquinas, stated that one of the most important conditions for receiving Holy Communion is that we have an ardent hunger and thirst for Jesus. A verse from the Psalms further illustrates this point of hunger: "As the deer yearns for the running streams, so my soul thirsts for you, my God."

The Holy Eucharist is not something we simply watch. Catholics are invited to join actively through prayer, responses, singing, and attentive listening. Participating wholeheartedly deepens our worship.

### 6) Receiving Holy Communion Without Preparation:

For us to receive worthy, we must be in a state of grace. This means that we must be free from mortal sin. The two sacraments of Confession and Holy Communion work together in support of each other.

# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

The more pure, clean, and transparent the soul, the more abundant the graces upon the reception of Holy Communion.

The Eucharist is truly the Body and Blood of Christ, not an ordinary symbol. If a person is conscious of grave sin, the Church encourages receiving the Sacrament of Confession before approaching Holy Communion. Therefore, confess often to enhance the efficacy of your Holy Communions!

✠ The Holy Mass is one of the greatest treasures of the Church. By approaching it with greater reverence and devotion, we open our hearts more fully to God's grace.

Bringing Christ to the World:

Finally, in imitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary, who received Jesus into her Immaculate Heart at the Annunciation and went in haste to bring Jesus to others, let us bring Jesus to others and bring others to Jesus.

Dear friends in Jesus and Mary, let us strive often to receive Jesus, the Bread of Life with greater love, fervor, and devotion. Our salvation and the salvation of countless souls depend on this most sublime truth and practice.

Our Lady of the Eucharist, pray for us.
