July 14: St. Kateri Tekakwitha

St. Kateri Tekakwitha (1656–1680) is the first Native American to be canonized as a saint by the Roman Catholic Church. Known as the "Lily of the Mohawks", her life is defined by deep resilience, devotion to her Catholic faith, and a profound connection to the environment.

She is widely revered as the patron saint of ecology and the environment (often honored alongside St. Francis of Assisi), as well as an advocate for Native people.

Her life is remembered at major locations, including the National Shrine of St. Kateri Tekakwitha in Fonda, New York, and the Shrine of Our Lady of Martyrs in Auriesville.

We also have a statue of St. Kateri in the back of our church on the cry room side.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



"Be Good Soil"

My Sisters and Brothers,

On the Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary time, we come to listen to the familiar Gospel, the Parable of the Sower. The seed is the Word of God. The Sower is generous, scattering the seed everywhere. The question is not whether God speaks to us—He always does. The real question is: What kind of soil is my heart?

Jesus speaks of four kinds of soil, but only the good soil bears an abundant harvest. Good soil is a heart that is humble, prayerful, receptive, and obedient. It listens to God's Word, treasures it, and puts it into practice. As Catholics, we cultivate this good soil through daily prayer, reading Sacred Scripture, frequent reception of the Holy Eucharist, regular Confession, and works of charity. The more we allow God's grace to remove the rocks of pride, the thorns of worldly distractions, and the hardness caused by sin, the more fruitful our lives become.

The prophet Isaiah assures us that God's Word is never empty. Just as rain and snow make the earth fruitful, God's Word always accomplishes His saving purpose. If we welcome His Word with faith, it will transform our minds, strengthen our hearts, and bear fruit in our families, our schools, our workplaces, and our communities.

Saint Paul reminds us in Romans that although we experience suffering in this life, we await the glory God has prepared for His faithful children. Like creation itself, we long for renewal and redemption. Good soil is patient soil. It trusts God even during trials, knowing that every act of faith, hope, and love prepares us for eternal glory.

Today, let us ask ourselves: Am I allowing God's Word to take deep root in my heart? May the Holy Spirit make each of us good soil, producing a harvest of holiness, compassion, faithfulness, and joy—thirty, sixty, and a hundredfold—for the glory of God and the building up of His Kingdom.

Dear Friends, thank you for being that "Good Soil", because each one of you have contributed and continue to do so with your time, talent and treasure. Your service is more than volunteering; it is a response to God's call to love and serve one another. Through your commitment, lives are touched, faith is strengthened, and our parish/ School becomes a true family of God. Whether your generosity and ministry are seen or unseen, your faithful service reflects the love and compassion of Jesus and helps build up His Church.

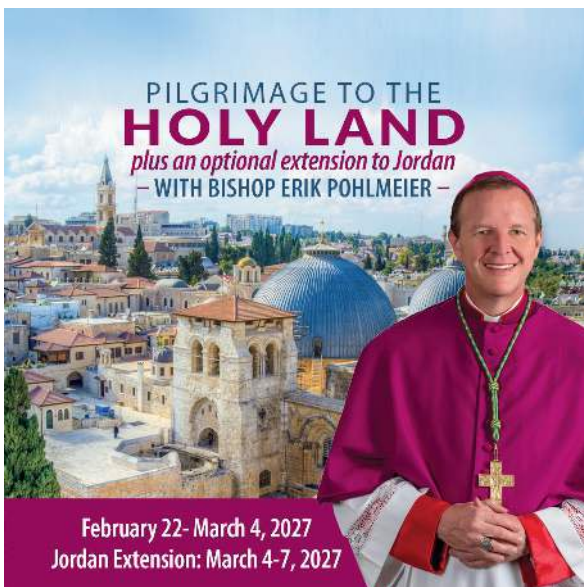


2026 NFP AWARENESS WEEK
