# MASS INTENTIONS



## August 4: St. John Vianney

Saint John Vianney (1786–1859) was a French parish priest known as the Curé d'Ars, celebrated for his deep holiness, extensive work in the confessional, and as the patron saint of parish priests.

Born on May 8, 1786, in Dardilly, France, growing up during the religious upheavals of the French Revolution. Assigned as the parish priest of the remote village of Ars in 1818, where he worked to transform the spiritually neglected community. Spent up to 16 to 18 hours a day hearing confessions, drawing tens of thousands of pilgrims to Ars annually by the 1850s.

Died on August 4, 1859, in Ars, France, which remains a major pilgrimage site. Named the universal patron saint of all parish priests and parish clergy worldwide by Pope John XXIII.

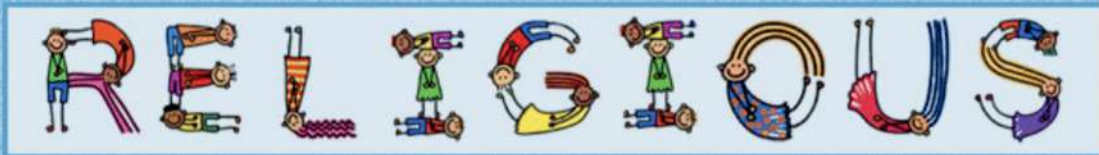

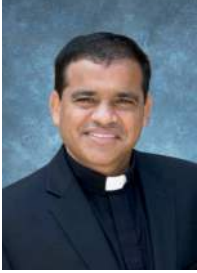

# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



## "EUCHRISTIC NOURISHMENT"

My Sisters and Brothers,

This weekend liturgical readings invite us: "Come to the water... come, receive without paying" (Isaiah 55:1–3). This invitation finds its fullest meaning in the Holy Eucharist. God freely offers us not ordinary food, but His Son, Jesus Christ, the Bread of Life, who nourishes our souls with His true Body and Blood, as the spiritual food for our journey.

In the Gospel of Matthew 14:13–21, Jesus feeds the five thousand with five loaves and two fish. This miraculous feeding points forward to the greater miracle of the Eucharist, where Christ continues to feed countless believers with Himself at every Holy Mass.



The Eucharist is not merely a symbol; it is the Real Presence of Jesus Christ, strengthening us in grace, forgiving our sins, deepening our communion with Him and with one another, and preparing us for eternal life.

As Catholics, let us approach the altar with faith, reverence, and hearts prepared through repentance. Having been nourished by Christ in the Eucharist, may we go forth to nourish others with His love, mercy, compassion and truth in our daily lives

## Did you Know?

### Satan's Drink.....

A cup of hot coffee is the favorite drink of many to begin their day. However, coffee was not always accepted in Western society. Arab shepherds and Islamic clerics were the first to cultivate and brew coffee beans. Because of these origins, Europeans originally did not embrace coffee. Some even called it "Satan's drink."

The turning point came with Pope Clement VIII, who reigned from 1592 to 1605. His advisors urged him to condemn coffee, hoping the Church would issue a ban.

But the story goes that Pope Clement VIII asked to try it himself before deciding.

After taking a sip, history was changed. Pope Clement reportedly declared, "This Satan's drink is so delicious that it would be a pity to let the infidels have exclusive use of it."
