August 14: St. Maximilian Kolbe

St. Maximilian Kolbe was a Polish Franciscan priest who gave up his life to save a fellow prisoner at the Auschwitz concentration camp during World War II.

Militia of the Immaculata to spread the faith and established a massive friary and publishing center in Poland called Niepokalanów.

After surviving weeks in an underground starvation bunker while leading prayers for the other condemned men, he was killed with an injection of carbolic acid on August 14, 1941. He was canonized as a martyr of charity by Pope John Paul II in 1982.

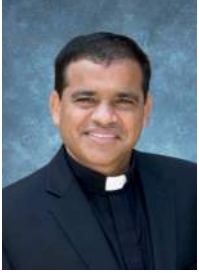

Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary celebrates Mary being taken body and soul into heaven, sharing fully in Christ's victory over death. It reminds believers that holiness leads to eternal life, and that Mary continues to guide and intercede, offering hope that God's promise of resurrection is meant for all.

AROUND OUR PARISH

The feast, celebrated on August 15, proclaims the dignity of Mary and the hope of eternal life promised to all who follow Christ. It reminds us that Mary's role as Mother continues in heaven, where she intercedes for the Church. The Assumption highlights not only Mary's special place in salvation history but also God's promise of resurrection and eternal life for all the faithful.

Practical Lessons:

Hope in Eternal Life: Mary's Assumption reminds us to keep our eyes fixed on heaven. When life feels overwhelming—whether through illness, grief, or worry, we can remember that this life is not the end. We, too, are destined for eternal life with God.

Honor the Body as God's Gift: Since Mary's body was assumed into heaven, her Assumption reminds us to respect our own bodies and those of others. In daily life, this can mean practicing healthy habits, avoiding what harms us, and treating others with dignity in both word and action.

Ask Mary's Intercession: Just as Mary interceded at the Wedding at Cana, she continues to intercede for us in heaven. Make it a habit to bring daily struggles, stress, family challenges, or even small anxieties—to her in prayer, asking her to carry them to her Son.

PRAYER:

O Most Blessed Virgin Mary, assumed body and soul into heavenly glory, we ask for your intercession. Pray for us, that we may remain faithful to Christ, care for the bodies and souls entrusted to us, and live with the hope of eternal life. Guide us closer to your Son, so that we may one day share in the joy of heaven. Amen.

School Safety Project Finished

I am happy to share that the school safety project we have been working on was completed over the summer. This project included keyscan access controls on all school and gym doors, new door and gate intercoms, security gates around the school building, additional security cameras, and a new fiber line connecting the school and gym communication systems.

These improvements will help make the school campus safer and more secure for our students, teachers, staff, and visitors.

This project was made possible through a partnership between the money the school raised, a state grant, and financial support from our parish that I approved. DEVOTION: THE 9 FIRST FRIDAYS

How to Complete the First Fridays Devotion:

1. Receive Holy Communion on each First Friday;
2. The nine Fridays must be consecutive;
3. They must be made in honor and in reparation to His Sacred Heart.

Act of Reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus

Sacred Heart of Jesus, animated with a desire to repair the outrages unceasingly offered to Thee, we prostrate before Thy throne of mercy, and in the name of all mankind, pledge our love and fidelity to Thee! The more Thy mysteries are blasphemed, the more firmly we shall believe them, O Sacred Heart of Jesus! The more impiety endeavors to extinguish our hopes of immortality, the more we shall trust in Thy Heart, sole hope of mankind!

The more hearts resist Thy Divine attractions, the more we shall love Thee, O infinitely amiable Heart of Jesus! The more unbelief attacks Thy Divinity, the more humbly and profoundly we shall adore It, O Divine Heart of Jesus! The more Thy holy laws are transgressed and ignored, the more we shall delight to observe them, O most holy Heart of Jesus!

The more Thy Sacraments are despised and abandoned, the more frequently we shall receive them with love and reverence, O most liberal Heart of Jesus! The more the imitation of Thy virtues is neglected and forgotten, the more we shall endeavor to practice them, O Heart of Jesus, model of every virtue! The more the devil labors to destroy souls, the more we shall be inflamed with desire to save them, O Heart of Jesus, zealous Lover of souls! The more sin and impurity destroy the image of God in man, the more we shall try by purity of life to be a living temple of the Holy Spirit, O Heart of Jesus!

The more Thy Holy Church is despised, the more we shall endeavor to be her faithful children, O Sweet Heart of Jesus! The more Thy Vicar on earth is persecuted, the more we will honor him as the infallible head of Thy Holy Church, show our fidelity and pray for him, O kingly Heart of Jesus! O Sacred Heart, through Thy powerful grace, may we become Thy apostles in the midst of a corrupted world, and be Thy crown in the kingdom of heaven. Amen.

12 Promises of the Sacred Heart to St. Margaret Mary

1. I will give them all the graces necessary for their state of life.
2. I will give peace in their families.
3. I will console them in all their troubles.
4. I will be their refuge in life and especially in death.
5. I will abundantly bless all their undertakings.
6. Sinners shall find in my Heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy.
7. Tepid souls shall become fervent.
8. Fervent souls shall rise speedily to great perfection.
9. I will bless those places wherein the image of my Sacred Heart shall be exposed and venerated.
10. I will give to priests the power to touch the most hardened hearts.
11. Persons who propagate this devotion shall have their names eternally written in my Heart.
12. In the excess of the mercy of my heart, I promise you that my all powerful love will grant to all those who will receive Communion on the First Fridays, for nine consecutive months, the grace of final repentance: they will not die in my displeasure, nor without receiving the sacraments; and my Heart will be their secure refuge in that last hour.

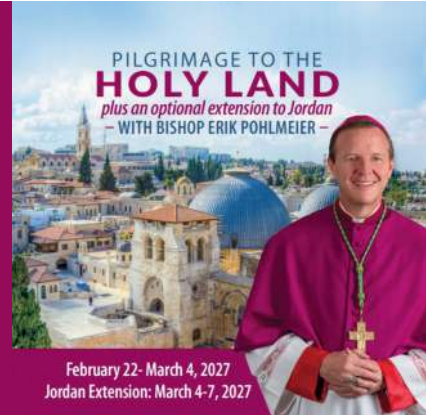

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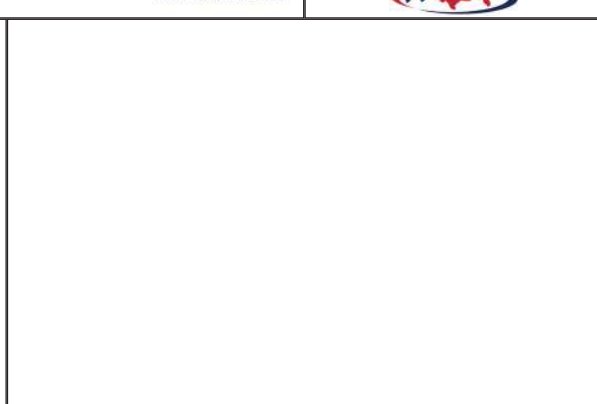
