August 21: St. Pope Pius X

Pope Pius X (born Giuseppe Melchiorre Sarto in 1835) served as the Vicar of Christ from 1903 until his death in 1914.

Known as the "Pope of the Eucharist," he was a humble pastor who promoted daily communion, and lowered the age for children's first Communion to 7. He promoted sacred music, particularly Gregorian chant, and renewed certain liturgical practices.

Pope Pius X required a strict anti-modernist oath from all Catholic clergy. He also fought against political efforts by secular governments to interfere with church property and affairs, notably in France.

He was canonized a saint in 1954.

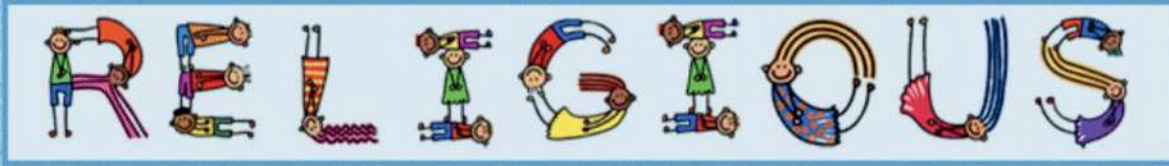

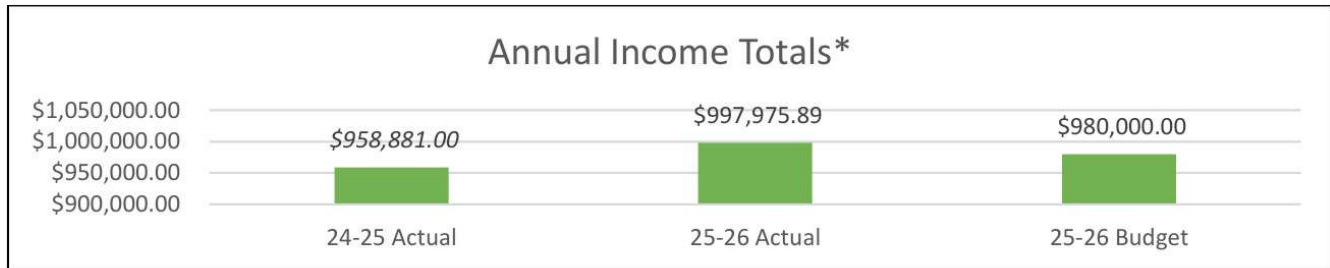

Annual CHURCH Financial Report
Fiscal Year Ended on June 30, 2026

Thank you for your generosity and stewardship to our faith community! The following report provides a summary of our parish income and expenses from the past fiscal year (i.e., July 2025-June 2026).

Income Totals – Snapshot of the church’s income

Our ‘25-‘26 total actual income exceeded our budgeted projection and the previous year’s actual. The caveat to the ‘25-‘26 income actual total is that it was significantly influenced by an endowment donation and two major irregular donations which all together was approximately \$71,039.64. We are thankful for the generosity of those donors. **Please note, all Family Life Center income is not included in the totals reflected in this bar graph, but instead are explained in the last section.*



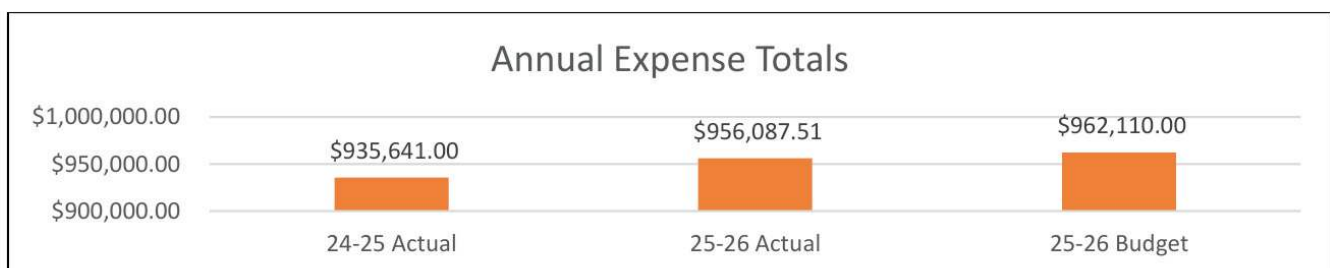
Major Sources of Income – Where does a majority of our money come from?

The top two major sources of income for the ‘25-‘26 fiscal year were the offertory collection and the FLC contributions. There was a shift in trends in our income this previous year: the offertory ended in a deficit while on the other hand, the FLC pledges exceeded our projections greatly. These trends indicate that continued careful budgeting and stewardship will be important as we plan for the years ahead.

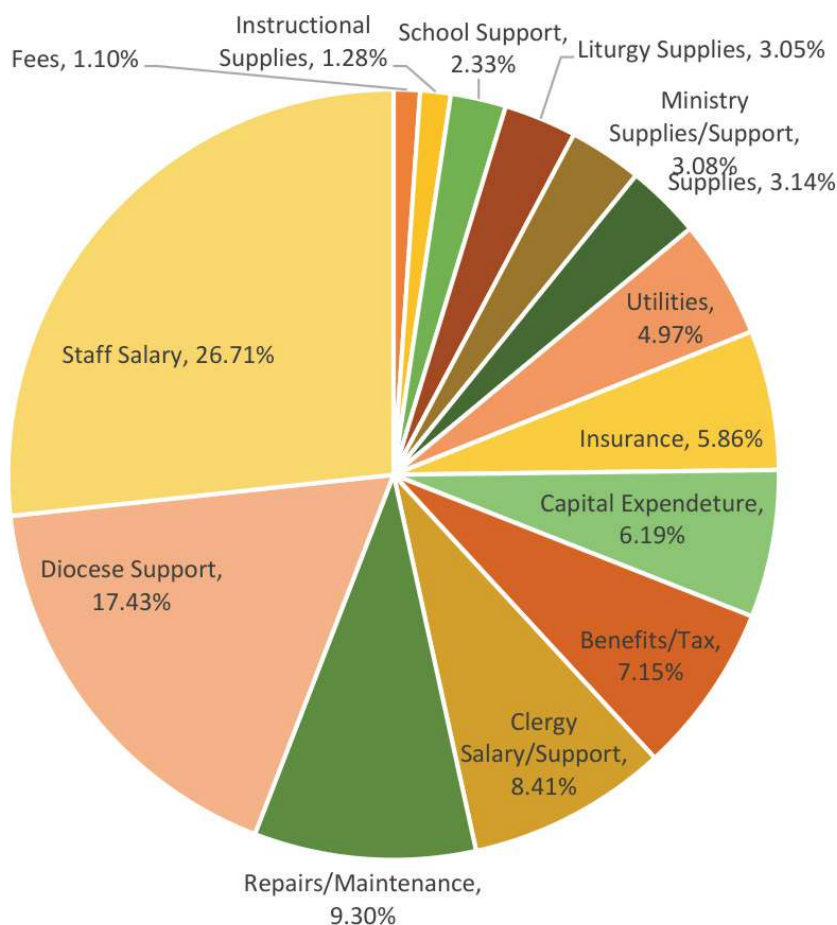
Expense Totals – Snapshot of the church’s spending

Major Projects this past year – What cost us the most?

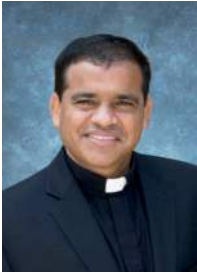
Through your generosity, the parish completed several major maintenance projects this year. These included replacing the roofs on the church, parish office, and rectory (\$55,610.00); repairing and repainting the rectory exterior (\$7,700.00); restoring all 14 wooden church doors (\$2,500.00); and repairing the irrigation systems serving the church, parish office, Family Life Center, and school campus (\$4,028.99).

Family Life Center Mortgage Update

The previous year's actual contribution income total was \$125,490.26. Expense for the FLC still includes the monthly mortgage payment of \$5,770.60 and the insurance costs of \$24,000 for the year.

The balance of the FLC mortgage loan was \$40,434.45 at the end of June. The church will be able to retire this mortgage by the end of 2027. We thank you for your support!
