

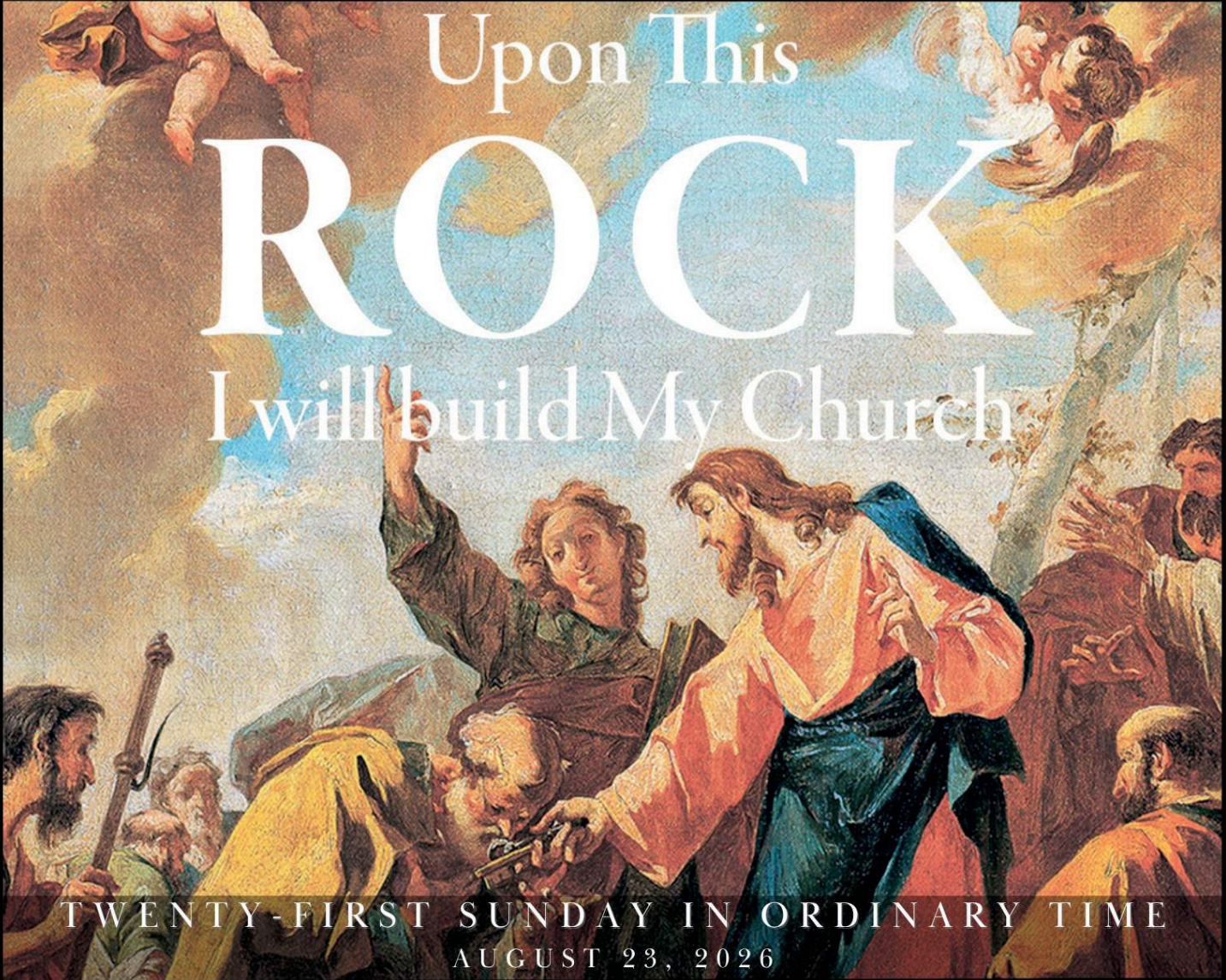

MASS INTENTIONS



August 28: St. Augustine

St. Augustine of Hippo (354–430 AD) was a foundational Catholic bishop, philosopher, and theologian from North Africa. His profound writings—including the *Confessions* and *The City of God*—shaped Western philosophy, medieval theology, and the Catholic views on grace, free will, and human nature. He was born in Thagaste (modern Algeria) to a pagan father and a devout Christian mother (St. Monica) and in his youth lived a worldly and unchaste life. Eventually, Augustine experienced a dramatic conversion in Milan in 386 AD after hearing a voice say "take and read" where he started reading St. Paul's letters. He then was baptized by St. Bishop Ambrose and returned to North Africa. Later on, he was ordained a priest and fought against heresies from his time.

St. Augustine is a Doctor of the Church and is the namesake of our diocese.

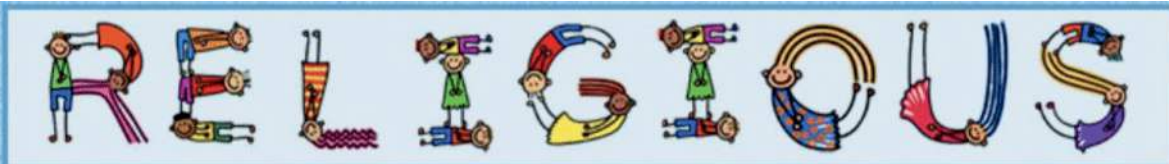
LECTORS TRAINING

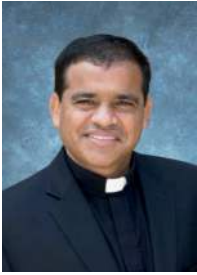

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

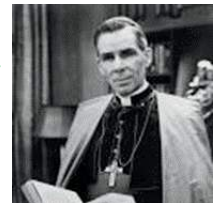


“WHO DO YOU SAY THAT I AM”.

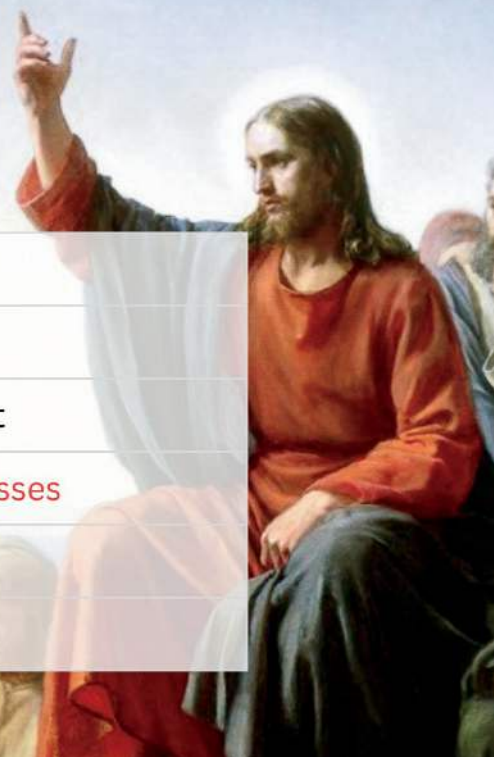

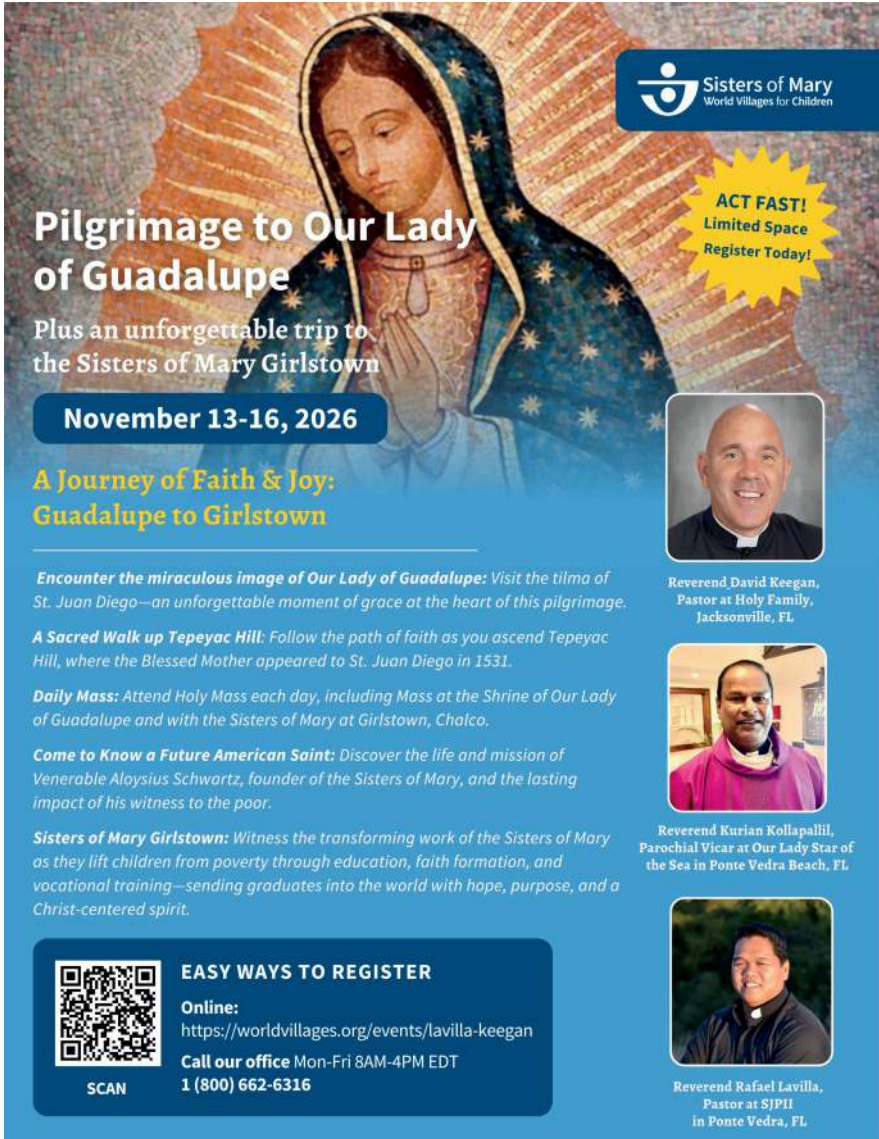

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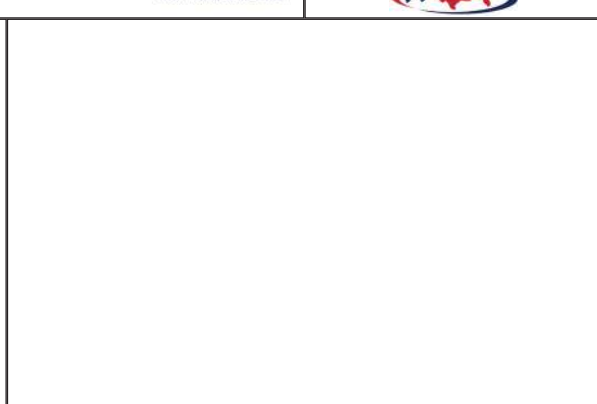
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
