September 3: St. Gregory the Great

St. Gregory was born to a noble, wealthy family. He served as the prefect (mayor) of Rome in his early thirties and eventually left public office to turn his family home into a monastery and lived as a devoted monk.

St. Gregory was elected pope in 590 during a time of plague, floods and famine. He coined the papal title of "servant of the servants of God" and his papacy was known for feeding the poor, negotiating peace with invading tribes, and managing church lands with great skill. He is also the one who promoted and codified the sacred music known as Gregorian chant.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Month of September – Mary Mother of Compassion



Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Month of September is dedicated to Our Lady of Sorrows or Mary Mother of Compassion, the Patroness of the Congregation of the Missionaries of St. Francis de Sales (MSFS). This feast is celebrated on September 15th under title of “Our Lady of sorrows”. This title, given to Mary, our mother, focuses on her intense suffering and grief during the passion and death of her son Jesus. This suffering was not just about the passion and death of Jesus. It included all other moments of suffering in her life such as the flight into Egypt, the loss of the child Jesus in the Temple, the meeting of Jesus on His way to Calvary, standing at the foot of the cross, holding the body of Jesus when He was taken down from the cross, and the burial of Jesus. The prophesy of Simeon that a sword would pierce Mary’s heart was fulfilled in these events. For this reason, Mary is sometimes portrayed with her heart exposed and with seven swords piercing it. More importantly, each new suffering was received with the courage, love, and trust that echoed her fiat, “let it be done unto me according to Thy word,” first uttered at the Annunciation.

So, I would like to encourage you to take a few moments this month to meditate and draw inspiration and strength from our Mother of Compassion. It is good for us to meditate on how this compassionate mother lived through her difficult moments. The image of the sorrowful mother reflects the wisdom of Jesus as he proclaimed it in the very beginning of his ministry: “Blessed are they who mourn, for they will be comforted” (Mathew 5:4) and “Be Compassionate just as your father is compassionate” (Luke.6:36).

The Gospel of John, chapter 19, tells us the beautiful and inspiring story of how Jesus, even as he hung on the cross, was thinking of other’s pain rather than his own. He stepped into the sorrow of others around him. The same chapter also tells us how those who loved him remained faithful and loyal to the one they loved as he suffered and eventually died on the cross. They stepped in and shared each other’s sorrow.

This is what the sorrowful mother did. She stepped into the pain, rejection, loneliness, anguish, and passion of her son and that of his disciples, without going under. She stood strong and steadfast for her son and for his disciples. She became strength for the suffering, lonely, rejected and sorrowful. She emerged from her pain and sorrow to become for us a fearless, powerful, courageous, and moving figure.

Let us be inspired by the example of the compassionate mother and learn to be present to each other in times of disappointment, pain, suffering and sorrow. Let us also remember the many mothers and fathers who must carry heavy burdens and be a source of support for them. Take a moment to be still and reflect on what you may do to lighten someone’s burden today or how you may bring comfort to those that you know are grieving their loss!

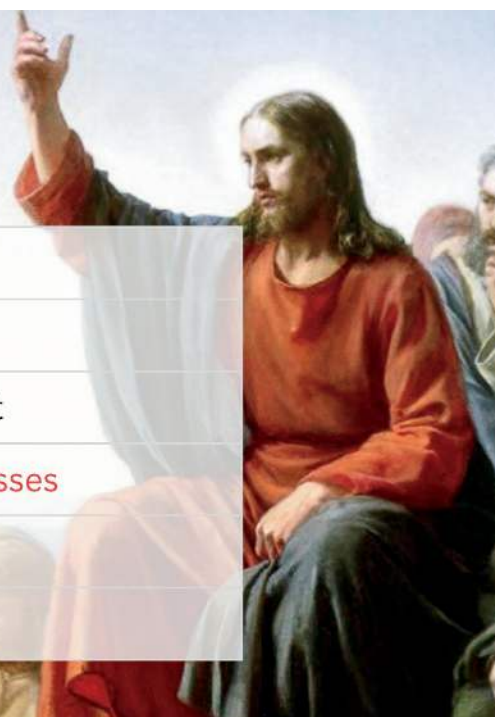
