
Interested in Becoming Catholic?

DID YOU KNOW? PARTS OF THE MASS...

With the anaphora or Eucharistic Prayer comes to the heart of the celebration. Parts of the Eucharistic Prayer are the:

Preface: the Church gives thanks in unending praise

Epiclesis: the Church asks the Father to send down his Holy Spirit on the bread and wine so that by his power they may become the body and blood of Jesus Christ. Also, that those gathered to take part may be one body and one spirit.

Institution narrative: by the power of the words and the action of Christ, and the power of the Spirit, Christ's body and blood are make sacramentally present under the species of bread and wine.

In the anamnesis: the Church calls to mind the Paschal Mystery, the sacrifice of that reconciles us to the Father. (CCC#1351-1354)

BISHOP ESTÉVEZ SUPPORTS INVESTIGATION BY FLORIDA'S ATTORNEY GENERAL

The Florida Attorney General announced (Oct. 4, 2018) they will investigate the Diocese of St. Augustine along with the other Florida dioceses to ensure the Church is properly handling allegations of sexual abuse of minors by clergy and church personnel.

Bishop Felipe Estévez said he is supportive of the investigation and the diocese will cooperate fully throughout the process.

"This has been a very painful period for all Catholics. I hope the outcome of this investigation and other acts of transparency by the dioceses in Florida will bring about greater trust in the Church. Our goals are similar – to ensure the safety of all children and vulnerable adults and to prevent perpetrators of abuse from serving in active ministry," said Bishop Estévez.

In 1989, the diocese initiated a process for reporting and reviewing suspected abuse by clergy and church personnel. An extensive program of education and criminal background checks by the FDLE and the FBI followed to ensure our children and vulnerable adults are safe. Allegations of sexual abuse are addressed promptly and thoroughly, providing pastoral care to victims and their families. We have a zero-tolerance policy to guarantee that allegations are reported to authorities and that anyone found to have committed abuse will be confronted swiftly and justly.

"I pledge continued efforts to protect those who cannot protect themselves. We must act on behalf of victims of abuse and their families in order to bring them the love, healing, and light of Christ," Bishop Estévez said.

We call upon the people of our community to contact local law enforcement if you have been abused or you know of abuse. If you are uncomfortable for any reason with the Church providing help, we can connect you with appropriate community services by calling our Victim Assistance Coordinator at (904) 208-6979.

And while the diocese supports a review of our safe environment program, we are pleased to hear that the Attorney General is not limiting this investigation to the Catholic Church, but <u>all</u> organizations and institutions who have access, directly or indirectly, to children and vulnerable adults.

Out of respect for the Attorney General's investigation, the diocese will not comment further on the review of its files until the state has completed its investigation.

COUNTY OFFICIALS REPORT THAT THE AREA WILL BE WITHOUT ELECTRIC POWER FOR AT LEAST 4 WEEKS, THAT RESIDENTS ARE LIVING IN TENTS, UNDER PLYWOOD LEAN-TOS, TARPS AND WHATEVER SHELTERS CAN BE FASHIONED. THESE PEOPLE ARE IN DESPARATE NEED, MOSTLY OF:

INFANT PROVISIONS/ BABY FOOD/DIAPERS

BATTERIES CLEANING SUPPLIES/SANITARY WIPES/DISENFECTANT PAPER TOWELS TOILETRIES/PAPER/TOOTHPASTE/BRUSHES ANIMAL FOOD/DOG AND CAT NON-PERISHABLE FOOD


