

FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

TO LIVE WITH JESUS IS TO REALLY LIVE:

As we begin the month of May we have set of celebrations. First of all, on 1st May, St. Joseph is venerated as an ideal worker, teaching us that work does not constitute the punishment imposed on human being instead, work indicates that human being is the cooperator with God. Month of May is dedicated for the devotion to Mother Mary; therefore, the May Crowning. And then our second-grade children receive the Lord for the first time in the Holy Eucharist. We are very happy for them and we congratulate them. Congratulations to their parents and their Catechism teachers too. May they always experience the grace and the overflowing blessings from the Lord.

Today's Gospel is taken from our Lord's discourse at the Last Supper. He is saying farewell to his disciples. Although they may not know it, Jesus knows that by the next day he will be dead. His talk at the Last Supper reveals his deepest and most precious thoughts. As his disciples we need to hang on to his every word. He is speaking his final words of love. After he has gone, he wants us to bear fruit, abundant fruit and fruit that will last.

Of ourselves we can do nothing. There is no pint in trying. Our efforts may well be full of 'sound and fury but signifying nothing'. There is only one way to have successful life: "Make your home in me, as I make mine in you". He wants you to live in him as you live in your own home. The relationship has all intimacy and relaxed atmosphere of a home.

This is the religion he has come to found. It is not an organization of rituals and set of prayers, of dress and diet. It is a life with him in the close and warm intimacy of a loving family.

"Make your home in me" Love with me and we will share life together. We will share joys and sorrows, tragedies and triumphs. In everything we will be together. In everything we will be one. This is the desire of heart. While walking this earth he had been one with is disciples. Now when he is raised, he wants to be one in love with each of us. This will be by faith. The darkness of faith purifies us in our search for him. But he who searches also finds and there is brightness and a vision to be found in the search of faith.

How do I know if I am living on Christ? "Whoever keeps his commandments lives in God and God in him." We then experience his presence in us. "Whoever keeps my commandments is the one who loves me. 
