
### HOLY COMMUNION TO THE HOMEBOUND

# FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

### THE HIDDEN WAYS OF GOD


Parents of growing children sometimes have a heart-breaking experience. A child of theirs does not "catch" the faith that they have tried to teach and "have caught."

Recently, I heard a good story from grandparents who were in that situation. Their only child was indifferent to God and church as he grew up. He graduated, dated and married. He and his wife had a child. The grandmother was a real, grandmother. She told her grandchild stories of Jesus and how Jesus loved him, [she planted the seeds of faith.] The grandfather took the child for walks and took him fishing. He said God bless you to the child even when he didn't sneeze. [He cultivated the seed that his wife had planted].

Years passed and the grandparents were overjoyed when the grandchild wanted to know God, to have a relationship with God, like his grandparents - and completed the RCIC. After his confirmation, the parents saw the faith in their child and returned to the Lord as well. The story had a very happy ending.

We do not know how God is working out his plan of Salvation. However, we do know: "God so loved the world". "If God would give his Son, then he will not refuse anything". "Nothing is impossible to God". We can rest assured that the ultimate victory will be his.

The kingdom of heaven is like the seed sown in the field. The seed has an inner power which given the right conditions will cause it to flourish. "God's Word is alive and active, sharper than any two-edged sword".



This doesn't mean that we can sit down idle. We need to cooperate with the Farmer, but growth doesn't come through our efforts. The harvest comes from the quality of the seed's inner power.

First let us scatter the seed abroad. Unless it is scattered there can never be a harvest? We scatter the seed by a word, a gesture, an act of kindness and generosity in a selfish world, the daily unobtrusive good example of acts of love. We should never despair that what we do is a waste – whether it be a program on a DVD, on the radio or the television, whether it be our life of Christian and human love. They are all seeds.

Let us live consciously in the Holy Spirit. Let us be anointed by the Holy Spirit each morning before we begin our day. For when the Holy Spirit is present even the slightest gesture can bring about conversion.

As it turns out, little things do really mean a lot in the eyes of God. In fact, they mean everything!


