



FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK



IS IT WRONG TO WANT TO BE THE GREATEST? By no means. The question is what does it mean to be the greatest? Mark in his Gospel brings us close to the disciples without halos. They thought like all the rest. They argued about who was the greatest, who would rule over the others, have more authority and power, make the decisions and get respect and honor. They were ready to fight and jostle for a 'cabinet post' in Jesus' kingdom.

This is very human, and we even see it in the Church. In the history of the Church there were centuries when powerful families schemed and plotted to capture the Papacy. It meant power and wealth. To have a family member become a bishop was a matter of prestige and income. All very human, but alien to the mind of Jesus.

Jesus is God become man and God is love. Jesus is love in human form. Love never thinks of itself but of the beloved. Love never seeks its own interest. Love longs for the beloved to grow and become fully human. The lover willingly sacrifices, even to giving his or her life. This is how Jesus loved. He emptied himself giving himself day by day till he gave everything on the Cross so that we can become one day like God himself. He never thought of himself but only of us.

In the community he established which we call the Church Jesus wants this kind of love to dominate. Before he appointed Peter to feed his sheep and care for his lambs, he asked him: Peter, do you love me more than these? When Peter affirmed that he did, Jesus made him shepherd of his flock. Peter would love his people and pour out his life for them. In Jesus' Church we are to rule by love and give our lives in humble service so that our sisters and brothers may grow and come to the full stature of Christ.

This was a hard lesson for the apostles. We will see them still fighting about 'greatness' at the Last Supper and so Jesus got down on his knees and washed their feet. Even then Peter remonstrated. On the day of the Ascension, they asked him, 'Are you going to establish the Kingdom now?'

Is it wonder that we still think in terms of worldly power and authority, even in the Church? It is however still wrong. "This shall not happen among you" Jesus warned his disciples.

In our church whatever maybe your role, do you seek to put yourself at the service of others? Would others say that you never think of yourself but only of what you can do cheerfully for others to grow? Have you understood Jesus' idea of authority?

May we imitate Jesus and humbly put ourselves out for others' welfare.




