




FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

CHURCH INCOME AND EXPENSE

Financial support for the church increased compared to the prior year and compared to the budget for the current year as the support from our generous parishioners continued to grow for which we are most grateful.

Expenses were up from last year but in line with budget. Last year, the church support for the school was reduced as the school received grants from the Payroll Protection Program because of COVID.




Not included in these numbers are the projects we completed with donations for specific purposes including the Life Garden in memory of Monsignor James Heslin which enhances our campus.

The repaving and restriping of the church parking lot was the major improvement this year and was paid from our reserve fund and is not reflected in expenses above.

Our beautiful Family Life Center is being well utilized for events and different ministries. Although the building campaign has ended, the mortgage payments of \$5,771 per month continue and your continuing support allows us to meet this commitment. The current mortgage balance is \$571,342.

While we might recall difficult times and frustrations in 2021, we continue with faith, love, joy and hope, in 2022. The generosity of your gifts given to the Lord are modeled upon what the Three Kings presented to the newborn King. The times spent in daily Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, Rosary, Bible Study, Faith Formation Sessions and many gatherings of prayer and praises to the Lord spent by you, are very moving and a blessing.

The talent you share from ministering at Mass to making other's feel Christ's compassion and love by visiting the home-bound, bringing a meal or just a smile to many, and assisting at the food distributions, serving wine and cheese, pancakes, coffee and donuts and the way the grounds are taken care is impressive. The drawing will be held **Friday, March 4, 6:00 pm** in the Msgr. Heslin Hall. You do not






