

Mon, Tue, Thur, Fri. 9am to 3pm, Wednesday 9am to 7pm— Divine Mercy Chaplet is prayed, followed by Benediction Daily at 3pm.

This will be from Monday to Friday, except on holidays. Come at any day or hour to adore our Lord in the Most Holy Sacrament.

We are also having 40 hour devotions once a month. This will run concurrently with our weekday adoration and beyond. We start at 11:00pm on the 2nd Wednesday of every month until 3:00pm that Friday, encompassing both the Thursday and Friday Masses. After 4:00pm, access to the church will be through the code-enabled door of our adoration room.



FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

CARING FOR EVERYONE'S REPUTATION: Christmas is fast approaching, and the few days coming up should be prioritized for spiritual quality time between the approaching Christ and us. Today we focus on St Joseph, the silent man of the New Testament. He does not speak one word in the scriptures and yet he had a crucial role in the great mystery of the incarnation. He was a righteous man. (Mt 1: 19).

Joseph was 'a man of honor'. And so, when he discovered that Mary was pregnant, he decided to do the right thing. To protect his good name, he would divorce her, and to protect her name, he would do so quietly, without making a fuss. Reputations mattered to him.

"Joseph teaches us two ways in which we can prepare to celebrate Christmas. First, we must have care for other people's good name. For St Thomas Aquinas, a person's reputation is their most prized possession, and to destroy it is not just unjust but robbery. Even if what we say about other people is true, and they have done terrible things, it is still deeply wrong to destroy their name, unless there is some compelling necessity for the common good. We must resist the pleasure of passing on juicy gossip.

Can we learn to never say a word that will destroy the good name of another child of God, unless justice requires that we do so?

Secondly, we must dare to put our own good name in jeopardy if need be. We must take the risk, like Joseph, of being misunderstood and mocked. Cardinal Jean-Guenolé Marie Daniélou, SI, (14 May 1905 - 20 May 1974) was a Jesuit theologian and historian. He died on the staircase of a seedy block of flats, on his way to visit a prostitute. The newspapers were filled with nasty innuendo, but his friends knew that he was a deeply pastoral man, who followed the way of his Lord and was not afraid to reach out to the despised, whatever people might say.

Let Joseph teach us how to welcome God's son into our lives this Christmas, caring for everyone's reputation, and yet, if necessary, being unafraid to lose our own reputation."


