
- The Shroud of Turn (Jesus' burial shroud)

### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

#### THE LORD IS ALWAYS WITH US!

Up at the head table in the cafeteria, one of the nuns had placed a big bowl of bright red, fresh, juicy apples. Beside the bowl, she placed a note which read, "Take only one. Remember, Jesus is watching." At the other end of the table was a bowl full of freshly baked chocolate chip cookies, still warm from the oven. Beside the bowl was a little note scrawled in a child's handwriting which read, "Take all you want. Jesus is watching the apples!"





Today we celebrate the third Sunday of Easter. It is a time to reflect on the risen Lord and the joy and hope that his resurrection brings to our lives.

In the Gospel reading, we have the story of two disciples on their journey to Emmaus. They were downhearted because they thought that Jesus was dead, but then they encountered him on the road. At first, they did not

recognize him, but as he explained the Scriptures

to them, as he broke bread with them, their eyes were opened, and they realized that it was indeed Jesus.

Like the disciples on the road to Emmaus, we too can sometimes feel lost or unsure of our faith. However, we must remember that the Lord is always with us, and we can find strength and comfort in his presence.

Let us take time this week to reflect on the resurrection of Jesus and what it means for our own lives. May we be renewed in our faith, and may the risen Lord fill our hearts with joy and hope.
