





# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

#### GOOD SHEPHERD!

As we continue to journey through the Easter season, the Church invites us to celebrate the 4th Sunday of Easter, also known as Good Shepherd Sunday. On this day, we are reminded of Jesus' words in the Gospel of John: "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep" (John 10:11).




This image of Jesus as the Good Shepherd is one that is rich in meaning and significance for us as Catholics. In the ancient world, shepherds were seen as protectors and providers for their flocks, and Jesus uses this analogy to describe His own mission. He is the One who cares for us, watches over us, and guides us on our journey through life.

Jesus goes on to say: "My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me" (John 10:27). This is a powerful reminder that we are called to listen for the voice of the Good Shepherd in our lives, and to follow Him wherever He leads us. In a world that is often full of noise and distractions, it can be difficult to discern His voice. But if we take the time to pray and to reflect on His teachings, we will come to recognize His voice more clearly.

The Good Shepherd also reminds us of the importance of caring for others. Jesus lays down His life for His sheep, and we too are called to lay down our lives for others. This means being willing to make sacrifices for the sake of others, and to put their needs before our own. As St. John the Apostle writes, "We know love by this, that he laid down his life for us – and we ought to lay down our lives for one another" (1 John 3:16).

As we celebrate this Good Shepherd Sunday, let us renew our commitment to following Jesus, to listening for His voice, and to caring for others. Let us also pray for all those who are called to be shepherds in the Church – our priests, deacons, and bishops – that they may continue to lead and guide us on our journey of faith.

May the Good Shepherd bless and guide us always!
