

## FAMILY LIFE CENTER DEBT REDUCTION CAMPAIGN









Q - What is the Debt Reduction campaign goal?

A - Our goal is \$500,000 which is the current balance of our loan. It is crucial that we meet this pledge goal before the Fall season.

#### Q - Why do we need to pay off the loan early?

A - Paying the loan early will allow us to avoid an increase in the interest rate. Taking care of this balance before that interest increase would help us begin in accumulating funds for the repair, maintenance, and upgrading of our 6 facilities: church, church office, FLC, school, gym, and rectory. Repair and maintenance of our buildings happens year round and completing this loan would help establish a healthy future for our parish.

Q - What type of projects have been completed recently on our church-school campus? A - Examples of our recent completed projects include: renovation of the church lobby, hospitality room, 2 sacristies, 3 restrooms, and adoration chapel; the installation of the new church audio & video systems; the paving and re-lining of the campus parking lots; replacement of most of school roof; renovation of the school principal's office and 2 restrooms; and replacement of several school & church air conditioners.

## MISSION APPEAL: CONGREGATION OF THE SISTERS OF ST. THERESE

The Congregation of the Sisters of St. Therese is a Diocesan Congregation of religious women, in Cameroon, Africa, founded on the 25th of June 1963 to serve the needs of the church and to raise

the dignity of women. The Sisters are involved in education, health care, and socio-pastoral activities, as well as engaged in social justice and work with marginalized persons in prisons, street children, battered women, and internally displaced persons.

Following a 7-year ongoing political upheaval in the country, whole villages have been raised to dust, many people killed, hundreds of thousands have been displaced and schools have been shut down in the affected areas. Many girls, women, and children are stranded in the streets and forced into prostitution. In response to this new reality, the sisters have opened a shelter in a nearby city that is safe, where they provide a haven for some of the victims (women and children).



We provide rehabilitation, safety, security, mental health care, education, and skills training. We house the girls in a rented apartment which is now very small. We have bought land to construct a bigger shelter and staff house, where we would carry out poultry, and fish farming, agriculture, and soap making to support and provide sustainable skills for the displaced women and children. We need your support to continue these programs and continue to support the girls, women, and

children. With 266 one child returns to school and is taken care of for a whole year. The cost of the construction of a shelter is \$155348.
