



# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

The Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph

The simple person is free of duplicity, free of guile, free of deceitfulness. (St. Francis de Sales)

Dear Sisters and brothers,

On the feast of the Holy Family, we are given wonderful wise counsel from Ben Sira on family life. He offers practical guidelines on how to live out the commandment to honor one's father and mother. He invites his readers to see mutual love and care among family members as the highest standard.

During the second century before Christ, family structures and values began to break down among the Jews because of the influence of Greek culture and philosophy. Jesus Ben Sira had the wisdom to advise his people to maintain family cohesiveness. He knew that breakdown in family life was going to cause breakdown

in society as well. Our situation today is not much different from the time of Ben Sira.

Honor yourself and one another. Honor your spouse, your children, your parents, your commitments, your church, your country, your God. Be honorable men and women. Be noble in your ways.

St. Mathew's Gospel tells us about the character of Joseph. Joseph was a man of honor, noble, courageous, and tenacious. He was willing to risk trusting his dreams as coming from God. He was willing to invest all he had to keep the baby and the mother safe from all dangers. He was willing to move from place to place until he could settle into a situation where the mother and the child would be safe. It is in the safety of an ordinary home, in a safe and loving environment that children have opportunities to grow up to be mature, free, joyful, faith-filled, virtuous, and wise men and women. This is what Joseph provided for Mary and Jesus.

Be Safe. And be a safe person to be with. May your home be safe. Make your home a safe place, a sanctuary for yourself, for your spouse, for your children, for your parents, for your neighbors. Be safe! And look out for each other's safety!

Be grateful.... grateful for your family, however imperfect or broken it may be, be grateful. Be grateful for your spouse, for your children, for your parents, with all their imperfections.... just be grateful!

You cannot be grateful and bitter. You cannot be grateful and unhappy. You cannot be grateful and without hope. You cannot be grateful and unloving. So just be grateful and be happy, be hopeful and be loving. It's Christmas Season and it's God's gift of himself! Just be grateful!

## Happy, Healthy and a prosperous New Year, 2024

As we begin the New year, we are invited to look back and glean the wisdom we have gained and remember the good things that happened to us, the good things we have been able to do, the good people we have met, the blessings that came our way, etc. Keep them close to your heart, carry them gratefully, joyfully, and tenderly.

Take a few moments also to look back and remember the "not so good" things that happened to us and the "not so good people" who came into our life. Remember the shortfalls, difficult moments, trying times, etc. Trials and difficulties have a way of teaching us and they contribute to our maturity. Be open to learning from the difficult situations that you encounter.

Cultivate and nurture Gratitude. Because gratitude brings light and warmth into our hearts, spreads joy and radiates positive energy into the world. The more we consciously and consistently grow in our practice of gratitude, the more blessings we will experience.

As we begin again, let us resolve to be faithful to who we really are, to what we are called to do and to the commitments and promises that we have made. St. Paul advises us, "Be steadfast, persevering, my beloved brothers, fully engaged in the work of the Lord" (1 Corinthians 15:58). St. Francis de Sales advises us, "Be who you are and be that well so that you may bring honor to the master craftsman whose handiwork you are!" and "Go courageously to do whatever you are called to do." Let us strive to be men and women of hope, speak language of hope, be optimistic, nurture an optimistic and positive attitude, a spiritual posture of being confident and open to new possibilities. Let us pray for each other that we may be people of hope.

Let us begin this New Year with gratitude for yesterday, striving to be faithful today and nurturing hope for tomorrow...


