FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Holy Spirit Family, I wish each and every one of you a Very Happy Easter. May the risen Lord bless you abundantly.

What does Easter stand for? Of course, we have a multitude of possible answers. Let me share six of them with you. Let us start with the letters of EASTER!

- **E** Stands for the *empty tomb* that provides hope in a hopeless world. There are so many people searching for forgiveness, hope and meaning in this world. And the great message of Easter is that if Jesus Christ was powerful enough to move the stone and overcome the grave, then he is powerful enough to move the stones that are blocking our lives.
- A Stands for the *angel* who invited them to look. When the women came to the tomb, the first thing the *angel* did was to invite them inside. The *angel* said, "Come and see the place where he lay." Take a look at the evidence. And God still invites us to do that. Indeed, you can look for yourself. The evidence is there if you investigate evidence that he did rise again.
- **S** Stands for the *surprise* at an empty grave. Not many people expected Jesus to show up on that Sunday morning. What a surprise, what a shock his resurrection caused! Everyone involved was surprised at how it turned out. And that is the greatest *surprise* this world has ever known.
- T Stands for the word *tell*. The surprised were told to go and *tell* this good news to others. Do you know what the most effective mode of evangelism is? It's the same as it has been for a long time. The most effective mode of evangelism is one person inviting another person. Go and *tell!*
- **E** Stands for *excitement* that the women felt that morning. Early that first Easter morning, the disciples and the women who were the first to find the tomb empty didn't realize just how "good" Sunday was going to be.
- **R** Stands for the *Resurrected Lord* who is living today. In our deepest, darkest moments, when we don't think it can ever get better, the *Resurrection* gives us the hope that it can. We don't always see right how things are going to turn out. That was how it was for the disciples on Friday and Saturday. But what a difference a day makes. Victory is coming!

Some of us probably are living in day one. It is the day of the trial. And if you are getting hit from all sides, Easter encourages you to maintain hope. Because what a difference a day makes!

Some of us probably are living in day two like the disciples on Saturday. The heat of the trail may be over but now is the time of confusion and frustration and

discouragement. And if your faith is challenged, the future seems cloudy, the outcome uncertain, Easter encourages you to maintain faith. Easter day can make a big difference to your life.

And all of us are facing day three. Day three is day of victory, good news and renewed hope. And if you aren't there now, be assured that it's coming. Maintain your hope. Maintain your faith. Be encouraged and excited about day three, for it's the day of the Lord's

Resurrection!

May God Bless you all with a Holy and Peace-filled Easter!

IF YOU PLAN ON RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION ANYTIME SOON, PLEASE THINK ABOUT THIS:

That's Jesus youre receiving. God Himself. The One who made every galaxy and every atom, the One who brought YOU into existence and who is keeping you alive right now. He has arranged for you to consume him, so that you can have eternal life

Make absolutely sure that you don't take all that for granted when you receive—and if you do, then don't receive.

Consider what Jesus himself told St. Faustina to write down in her now-famous Diary, back in the 1930s:

"My daughter, write that it pains Me very much when religious souls receive the Sacrament of Love merely out of habit, as if they did not distinguish this food. I find neither faith nor love in their hearts. I go to such souls with great reluctance. It would be better if they did not receive me."

If you think Jesus' words describe your own current attitudes, don't despair! Let this be a wake-up call! Pray that God drives indifference and Luke warmness out of you, and then, the next time you go to Mass, make every effort to show renewed reverence and passion for what you are about to receive: Jesus Christ Himself, Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity!
