



## FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

#### REMEMBER HOW GENEROUS THE LORD JESUS WAS!


Our liturgical calendar this week invites us to celebrate three great saints of the church.

On June 29th we celebrate the solemnity of apostles Saint Peter and Saint Paul. Saints Peter and Paul are probably the most known of all the saints in the Catholic Church. It is a feast commemorating the martyrdom of the Apostles, Saints Peter and Paul of Tarsus in Rome. What makes them so famous is that both of them were chosen by Jesus in a very special way for the building of the Church, the mystical body of Christ.

We would probably go to confession to Peter sooner than to any of the other apostles. He is perhaps a more striking example of the simple fact of holiness. Jesus says to us as he said, in effect, to Peter: "It is not you who have chosen me, but I who have chosen you. Peter, it is not human wisdom that makes it possible for you to believe, but my Father's revelation. I, not you, build my Church."



Paul's experience of the risen Jesus on the road to Damascus was the driving force that made him one of the most zealous, dynamic, and courageous ambassadors of Christ the Church has ever had. But persecution, humiliation, and weakness became his day-by-day carrying of the cross, material for further transformation. The dying Christ was in him; the living Christ was his life.




On July 3rd, we celebrate Apostle Thomas. Poor Thomas! He made one remark and has been branded as "Doubting Thomas" ever since. But if he doubted, he also believed. He made what is certainly the most explicit statement of faith in the New Testament: "My Lord and My God!" and, in so expressing his faith, gave Christians a

prayer that will be said till the end of time. He also occasioned a compliment from Jesus to all later Christians: "Have you come to believe because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed" (John 20:29).

This weekend Gospel offers us two examples of Jesus reaching out to the poverty of human beings and giving them the richness of life.

Both Jairus and the woman suffering from a blood-flow come to Jesus with great hope and faith and humble themselves before him on their knees. Jesus receives each of them with great gentleness. When he speaks to the woman, he calls her "daughter" and publicly recognizes her as cured by her faith and now restored to cleanness in the community.

Then, Jesus comes to the home of Jairus and takes him and his wife out of the din of the mourners into their daughter's room. There, Jesus speaks gently to the young woman, takes her by the hand as she is restored to life, and instructs her parents to give her something to eat.



While you and I realize that our God has made us in his image, we also recognize our poverty when left on our own. We have come to know the gracious act of our Lord Jesus Christ: though he was rich, he became poor like us, so that by his poverty we might become rich. By Baptism, we were washed clean and restored to the fullness of God's life and love. By God's favor, we have that richness within us.

To seek Jesus like the apostles is our greatest task and to find him in the same manner is our greatest human achievement.

Ave Maria University

Andrew Dinan, Ph.D., is Associate Professor of Classics at Ave Maria University where he has taught since 2004. Since 2014 he has been involved with the effort to obtain the beatification of the Martyrs of La Florida, and in October 2015 he was sworn in as a member of the Historical Commission, which has been charged with evaluating the evidence for the various martyrdom events.

Dr. Dinan's address will focus on St. Augustine's understanding of martyrdom, especially his emphasis on the humanity of the martyrs. He will also be using the original letters of the Florida martyrs in order to provide a glimpse of their personalities, particularly their desires, fears, and concerns.
