FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

DO WE THINK IN GOD'S WAY? In the gospel Jesus asked His disciples who they think He was. But He began by asking them what people were saying about Him. That was easy for them. So, they said what others said about Jesus – that He was John the Baptist, or Elijah or one of the prophets. But that was just like a teaser. Because the next question that Jesus asked His disciples was what they themselves thought about Him. Who did they think He was?

That was certainly up close and personal and not that comfortable. Now they can't quote what other people were saying. They have to say what they personally think. Peter comes along with this divinely inspired proclamation "You are the Christ" and that saved the rest from that tight awkward situation.

But when Jesus began to teach them, He was destined to suffer grievously and to be put to death, Peter decided to come up with his own opinion and began to remonstrate with Jesus. With that, Jesus had to rebuke Peter with these rather sharp words: Get behind me Satan! Because the way you think is not God's way but man's.

Certainly, for Peter, it was one moment of inspiration followed by another moment of humiliation. Of all things, he was called "Satan"; what else can be worse. But the learning point that we can get from Peter's lesson is the way we think – do we think in God's way, or do we think in our own way?

And just as Jesus asked His disciples who they think He was, in what way do we see others and what do we think of them?

Butterflies are beautiful creatures. The pattern and color on their wings are truly amazing. Yet it is said that butterflies can't see their own wings. They can't see how beautiful they are, although everyone else can. In a way we are also like butterflies; we may not be able to see the beauty in us. But that should not prevent us from seeing the beauty in others.

When Jesus asked His disciples "Who do you say I am?" He was also asking them if they were seeing Him in God's way or is it in their own way. God's way of looking at people is always that of seeing the beauty in others. God created each of us with His image, and it is an image of love and beauty. When we see others with the love of God, then we are able to see the beauty in others. And when we see the beauty in others, then we too will begin to see the beauty in ourselves.


My First Interactive Mass Book


