FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK



A SYNOD ON SYNODALITY – COMMUNION, PARTICIPATION AND MISSION

"By walking together, and together reflecting on the journey made, the Church will be able to learn from what it will experience which processes can help it live communion, to achieve participation, to open itself to mission." – Pope Francis

Pope Francis, on the 24 April 2021, approved a new synodal program for the XVI Ordinary General Assembly

of the Synod of Bishops. Initially the Synod, "For a synodal Church: communion, participation and mission," was hoped to commence in the month of October 2022. However, it was delayed and now will begin in each local diocese on October 17, 2021. Pope Francis will formally open the universal synod in Rome on October 10th.

This path toward the celebration of the Synod consists of three phases, between October 2021 and October 2023, a diocesan phase and a continental phase that will give life to two different working documents and finally a conclusive phase at the level of the Universal Church. These three phases will lead up to a formal teaching document that will be provided to the universal Church in 2023.

During our local phase, we will ask for input in the areas presented in the preparatory document from all the People of God via a variety of methods. It is hoped that as many people as possible take part in this historical event and that it truly will bear fruit for the Diocese of St. Augustine as we listen to one another. One method that will be used is gathering in small groups across the diocese in prayerful discernment. The discernment gathering for our deanery (South Jacksonville) will take place on February 24, 2022, at 6:30 p.m. at Assumption, Jacksonville.



WORLD MISSION SUNDAY

World Mission Sunday, organized by the Society for the Propagation of the Faith, is a day set aside for Catholics worldwide to recommit themselves to the Church's missionary activity through prayer and sacrifice. World Mission Sunday will be celebrated within our diocese on Sunday, October 24th, 2021. The offerings that will be collected are destined for a common fund of solidarity distributed, in the Pope's name, by the Society for the Propagation of the Faith among the missions and missionaries entire world.
