



#### "FOR A SYNODAL CHURCH: COMMUNION, PARTICIPATION, AND MISSION"

**Opening of Synod on Synodality Big Success**: Bishop Estevez together with the representatives from all the parishes and entities of our Diocese celebrated the opening of the local phase of the Universal Synod on Synodality on Sunday, Oct. 17, at St. Joseph Catholic Church, Jacksonville. You can watch the Mass and hear the witness talks along with Bishop Estévez's address by visiting the diocesan YouTube channel at

What is next? The next step in our local process is a series of discernment evenings that will be held across the diocese at the following locations. Each evening will begin at 6:30:

Nov. 11 - St. Anastasia, St. Augustine

Dec. 9 - St. Matthew, Jacksonville

Jan. 13 - Sacred Heart, Fleming Island

Jan. 20 - St. Madeleine Sophie, High Springs

Feb. 3 – Queen of Peace, Gainesville


Feb. 24 – Assumption, Jacksonville

Each session will begin with quiet time in front of the Blessed Sacrament followed by small discernment group discussion on three questions. The People of God are asked to prayerfully consider the following questions before attending one of the discernment sessions:

**LISTENING**: Listening is the first step, but it requires an open mind and heart, without prejudice. How is God speaking to us through voices we sometimes ignore? How are the laity listened to, especially women and young people? What facilitates or inhibits our listening? How well do we listen to those on the peripheries? How is the contribution of consecrated men and women integrated? What are some limitations in our ability to listen, especially to those who have different views than our own? What space is there for the voice of minorities, especially people who experience poverty, marginalization, or social exclusion?

**SHARING RESPONSIBILITY FOR OUR COMMON MISSION**: Synodality is at the service of the mission of the Church, in which all members are called to participate. Since we are all missionary disciples, how is every baptized person called to participate in the mission of the Church? What hinders the baptized from being active in mission? What areas of mission are we neglecting? How does the community support its members who serve society in various ways (social and political involvement, scientific research, education, promoting social justice, protecting human rights, caring for the environment, etc.)? How does the Church help these members to live out their service to society in a missionary way? How is discernment about missionary choices made and by whom?

**FORMING OURSELVES IN SYNODALITY**: Synodality entails receptivity to change, formation, and on-going learning. How does our church community form people to be more capable of "walking together," listening to one another, participating in mission, and engaging in dialogue? What formation is offered to foster discernment and the exercise of authority in a synodal way?



**SECOND COLLECTION** 

There will be a second collection on **November 6 & 7** in support of the Congregation of the **Missionaries of Saint Francis De Sales** (MSFS). MSFS was founded in France in the year 1838 by Fr. Peter Marie Mermier to spread the renewal of faith in the Love of God, plant the Gospel in the mission lands of Africa and Asia and develop the society through education both spiritual and material, provide institutions of formation of priests and Catechists, and establish spirituality Centers to continue the work of St. Francis De Sales in our modern time. This Missionary Congregation is seeking our support and participation in their ministry to the world. Please be generous as your means allow in the second collection.
