

MAY I FIND JESUS IN MY LIFE AND MAKE SMOOTH HIS PATH!

Advent is the time not only for making external preparations for the feast of Christmas; it is also for inner reflection, to prepare ourselves for a conversion from within. Gospel gives us an answer to the question: How can we prepare ourselves worthily for the coming of Christ? Convert yourselves, do penance and prepare the way for the coming of the Lord.

How can we do it? There must be a change! Today, John the Baptist is crying out his Advent message in the desert: "Prepare the way of the Lord; make straight his paths." He is proclaiming repentance for the forgiveness of sins.


