## FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

#### **DO YOU SEE THE STAR?**

Today, the Church celebrates the feast of the Epiphany. Epiphany means a revelation or a manifestation. It means that the newborn Savior was revealed to the whole world through the wise men. But it was not as simple as it sounds. The wise men saw the star and they knew it was a special star – it was the star of the infant king of the Jews.



So where is this infant King of the Jews? Well, just follow the star. The solution is as simple as that. But not really that easy! Because obviously at times, they couldn't see the

star and that is why they ended up in Jerusalem because they supposed that the infant King would be born in a big city. It was the Word of God that showed them the way to Bethlehem and entering in 'they fell down and worshipped him'.

The Magi from the East, confidently following the Star of Bethlehem, seek to render homage to the newborn Infant lying in a manger. They find no pleasure in the beauty of the city of Jerusalem, or in the magnificence of Herod's court. Their hearts seek the little cave at Bethlehem and its little Child. They rigorously forsake every other pleasure so that they may more strongly find pleasure in God's presence in the Christ Child.

Let us come close to our Savior in the divine crib and listen to the many inspirations and affections that awaken us to God's goodness. It may be very difficult at times to trust in God. We may even feel no confidence in God. Yet in these times of difficulties, we still have the power to make a simple act of confidence in God. We can say, "While I feel no confidence in You, I know that you are my God, and that I am all yours."

## Scholarships for Florida School children

Step Up For Students believes that every child deserves the chance to succeed. Through the administration of several scholarship programs, Step Up For Students empowers parents to pursue and engage in the most appropriate learning options for their children. With the help of a Step Up For Students scholarship, you could send your child to a Catholic school near you.

#### SCHOLARSHIPS FOR PRIVATE SCHOOL

The Family Empowerment Scholarship for Educational Options (FES-EO) and the Florida Tax Credit (FTC) Scholarship Program give parents the ability to choose a school that best meets their children's needs by providing a scholarship to attend an eligible private school.

## $1/h_{o}$ is eligible?

Students in grades K-12 who meet one or more of the following:

- Financial need: Eligibility is determined by household income. For example, a family of four could have an income of nearly \$100,000 annually to qualify.
- Dependent children of a reservist or an active-duty member of the United States Armed Forces
- Children currently in foster or out-of-home care
- Siblings of students participating in the Family Empowerment Scholarship for Students with Unique Abilities

• A scholarship worth roughly \$7,000 to cover the cost of private school tuition, books, registration, testing and more.

- Children with one of 22 diagnoses including, but not limited to: autism spectrum disorder, Down syndrome, spina bifida and emotional, behavioral or intellectual disabilities
