FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

A SYNOD ON SYNODALITY - COMMUNION, PARTICIPATION AND MISSION

"By walking together, and together reflecting on the journey made, the Church will be able to learn from what it will experience which processes can help it live communion, to achieve participation, to open itself to mission." – Pope Francis

Pope Francis, on the 24 April 2021, approved a new synodal program for the XVI Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops. This path toward the celebration of the Synod consists of three phases, between October 2021 and



October 2023, a diocesan phase and a continental phase that will give life to two different working documents and finally a conclusive phase at the level of the Universal Church. These three phases will lead up to a formal teaching document that will be provided to the universal Church in 2023.

During our local phase, we are asked for input in the areas presented in the preparatory document from all the People of God via a variety of methods. It is hoped that as many people as possible take part in this historical event and that it truly will bear fruit for the Diocese of St. Augustine as we listen to one another.

What is Synodality? (From Pope Francis, letter on the 50th anniversary of the Synod of Bishops, October 17, 2015.)

- "Journeying together laity, pastors, and the Bishop of Rome"
- Greatest Example Acts of the Apostles Chapter 15
- Involves the prayerful discernment of the entire People of God
- Ancient principle of listening as a community to "what to the Spirit is saying to the Church" (Rev 2:7)

It is the task of the pope in union with his brother bishops after prayer and consultation with the entire People of God, to discern a path forward guided by the Holy Spirit.

How can we participate? One method that the Diocesan Steering Committee is using is gathering in small groups across the diocese in prayerful discernment. An "*Evening of Discernment*" in our area of the diocese, which is South Jacksonville Deanery will be on Thursday, February 24, 2022, at 6:30 p.m. @ Assumption, Jacksonville.

I understand that not all can make it to this "Evening of Discernment" and so wanted to provide you another method of participation: **Parish Synodality Town Hall**. As your pastor I invite you to make use of this opportunity as People of God to be involved in the decision-making process of the Universal Church by listening to the Holy Spirit through each other on the specific questions provided by the Vatican.

Scholarships for Florida School children

Step Up For Students believes that every child deserves the chance to succeed. Through the administration of several scholarship programs, Step Up For Students empowers parents to pursue and engage in the most appropriate learning options for their children. With the help of a Step Up For Students scholarship, you could send your child to a Catholic school near you.

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR PRIVATE SCHOOL

The Family Empowerment Scholarship for Educational Options (FES-EO) and the Florida Tax Credit (FTC) Scholarship Program give parents the ability to choose a school that best meets their children's needs by providing a scholarship to attend an eligible private school.

$(1/h_{0})$ is eligible?

Students in grades K-12 who meet one or more of the following:

- Financial need: Eligibility is determined by household income. For example, a family of four could have an income of nearly \$100,000 annually to qualify.
- Dependent children of a reservist or an active-duty member of the United States Armed Forces
- Children currently in foster or out-of-home care
- Siblings of students participating in the Family Empowerment Scholarship for Students with Unique Abilities

- Children with one of 22 diagnoses including, but not limited to: autism spectrum disorder, Down syndrome, spina bifida and emotional, behavioral or intellectual disabilities



• A scholarship worth, on average, \$10,400 to cover the cost of private school tuition, instructional materials, home education, tutoring and more.
