FASTING

ALMSGIVING

Fasting is the restriction of consumption so as to grow in gratitude for what God has provided and to further focus on God.

How can we live it?

What is it?

- Meditation of Holy Scripture, writings of the saints, fathers of the Church, spiritual authors, etc.
- Receiving the sacraments
- Daily acts of consecration or personal devotion
- Attending retreats, spiritual exercises, etc.

Examples for Lent:

- Praying the Stations of the Cross
- Daily reflection on Passion of Christ readings
- Attend Mass during the week other than Sunday
- Go to confession
- Increase personal prayer

How can we live it?

- Moderation in eating and drinking
- Reducing expenses on material things or luxurious things or events
- Abstaining from the internet, TV and other forms of entertainment for certain periods of time
- Fasting from slothfulness, gluttony, lust, gossip or other vices

- Offer some food or drink that you like for Lent
- Fast from phone use
- Give up one of your social media apps for Lent
- Avoid cursing, gossiping or unnecessary speech

What is it?

Almsgiving is the act of donating money,

service or goods to the poor or performing other acts of charity.

How can we live it?

- Dedicate time to your family, studies, or work
- Helping others through service or material goods
- Doing an act of charity
- Be generous with your virtues and gifts that God has given you

- Donating food or clothing to St. Vincent de Paul
- Offer your time in a ministry or event at the parish like the Fish Fry
- Dedicate your time at home to help another family member with a chore
- Listen to someone's story with love

FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

TRANSFORMING LIVES:

A ship was in a serious storm and in grave distress. The passengers were alarmed. One of them, against orders, went up to the deck and made his way to the pilot house. The pilot was at the wheel, but seeing the man was greatly frightened, he gave him a reassuring smile. Returning to the other passengers the man said, "I have seen the face of the pilot, he smiled. All is well."

As we continue our Lenten journey, Saint Francis de Sales has some encouraging words, quoting St. Paul: "My brothers and sisters, whom I love and long for, my joy and my crown, in this way stand firm in the Lord." Like Abraham before us, the Lord has made a covenant with us – a covenant sealed with the blood of his only begotten Son Jesus. Like Peter, James and John, we have heard the voice of the Father: "This is my chosen Son; listen to him."

Each day or each week, we come here to Eucharist to listen as Jesus speaks to us in the Scriptures and feeds us with his body, given up for us, and his blood, poured out for us. And today, we pray that the Father of light will restore our sight that we may look upon Jesus who calls us to repentance and a change of heart.

All of this is part of the "plentitude of our God" that we have been encouraged to reflect upon – and for good reason. When we allow ourselves to be immersed in God's overwhelming love, we will understand more clearly our need for repentance and a change of heart.

As our Lenten journey continues, let us be encouraged by Saint Francis de Sales and Saint Paul. As we stand firm in the Lord, may the love of Jesus, the beloved Son, grace our efforts to change our hearts.

Our weekend Mass times effective (and including) May 1st will be:


Saturdays @ 5PM Sundays @ 8:30AM & 11:00AM




