PRAYERS FOR THOSE IN RCIA

On the 3rd, 4th, and 5th Sundays of Lent, Catholic churches with adults preparing to be baptized at the Easter Vigil will perform three successive rites called "the Scrutinies." These rites have roots that date back to the early Church and are thematically linked to the Gospel reading of that Mass. The people preparing for the sacraments ("the Elect"), along with their godparents/sponsors, bow or kneel before the priest and the assembly, who pray for them silently and with a series of intercessions. Culminating in a prayer of cleansing and protection with the laying-on-of-hands, each Scrutiny is a step in preparing the Elect for the celebration and initiation soon to come.

As see in the Gospel readings for these weekends, the Scrutinies focusses on the theme of conversion or the turning of a soul back towards God while also praying for protection and cleansing.

Let us continue praying for our brothers and sisters that are going through this process as we welcome them into the Catholic Faith on Easter Vigil.

FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

GOD GIVES US SECOND CHANCES

As long as we never give up, we have a chance that things are going to get better. What a relief that we worship the God of second chances!

Do you know what the indisputable truth about human beings is? It is our infinite capacity to mess up. We are mistake prone humans. The Bible is full of people whose lives were messed up. In fact, they turned their backs on

God completely. But even more infinite than their ability to mess up their lives was God's desire to give them a second chance.

The Bible is full of stories to prove God's desire to give people a second chance. Moses, Jonah, Peter, and Paul are examples. Or the story of the prodigal son and the woman caught in adultery, and the lives of saints also are some examples.

God ignored the fact that Moses had failed before. God didn't care about Moses's lowesteem or speech disability. God gave Moses as many chances as he needed. Deliberately, consciously, stubbornly, the Prophet Jonah had run away from God. Yet, God came to the prophet and allowed him to carry on his ministry.

Peter denied and betrayed Jesus at the hour of crisis. Yet, after his resurrection, Jesus went looking for Peter. Peter learned that God is the God of second chance. Paul was zealous persecutor of the Christians. God gave him a second chance, a second chance for God's enemy!

History is full of individuals who had their first, second chance and many other chances before they succeeded.

When I read the stories of Moses, Jonah, Peter and Paul and the stories of thousands of men and women like them who have lived among us and still living among us, and especially the story of the fig tree in today's gospel, I say, "What a God!"
