# FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

### **RE-ESTABLISHING TIES**

In the gospel we confront a son cutting his relationship with his father. Asking for his share of the inheritance before his father is dead is something that is unheard of in that culture. The son is basically saying that he wishes for the death of his father, or he considered as if his father is already dead. He wanted to see the world. He wanted to eat, drink and be merry. Thus, he made the choice of death in the world instead of life at home. The

father gave his son what he desired. But eventually the son met with the consequences of his demands. The world mistreated him, made him starve and led him to loneliness and darkness. This son is a sober reminder that self-will will separate one from God the Father.

We must be careful what we ask for – God may give it to us. Our self-will can make us end up in addiction, compulsive living, alcohol, gambling, and unhealthy relationships. There are two sides to "Ask, and it shall be given." If the desire is for something wrong, then watch out! The prodigal son on his return home received the robe, ring, sandals, and feast. These four symbols are signs of acceptance – clothing, status, dignity and celebration. Thus, the story of the prodigal son is a story of re-establishing ties.

Our life principle is: 'Do not hurt anyone.' But we are humans prone to failures. A good family can have children that go astray hurting their parents. "People will do things to family that they would never do to a stranger." We all are going to drink the cup of suffering at one point in our lifetime. We all are going to get hurt at one point by our spouses, parents, children, brothers, sisters, employer and whoever we love, and whoever we think are loving us. We must be aware that not everyone thinks the way you do. Therefore, there will be misunderstandings, break-ups, separations, and abandonment.

There are three basic responses to any discouraging, disturbing or disappointing situation: Try to change the situation, accept it, or ignore it; fight, surrender, or flight; beat it, join it, or escape; uphold your standards, lower your standards, or go looking for better standards. Learn to embrace the difference. If you accept the pain, it cannot hurt you. Decide whether you want to live in anger or forgiveness. Knowing this and understanding this will help us to cope with betrayals, abandonment and above all try to re-establish our ties.


