

FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

DO WE RECOGNIZE JESUS?

Last year I went fishing with one of our parishioners. He had all the best equipment, and he had a map from his friend who published a fishing magazine, assured me that we would be catching lots of fish. Well, we caught no fish, we spent all most all day. We had sandwich and came back. We had good time, shared lots of stories, laughed, even though the day was filled with discouragement.





I know how the disciples felt, fishing all night, and catching nothing. But Jesus helps them in spite of their discouragement. When they follow his instructions and place their trust in Him, they catch fish and recognize Jesus as the Lord.

What strikes me about the post resurrection appearances of Jesus is how he pops up in ordinary places. On a walk to Emmaus, in an upper room and now he pops up on the beach. He cooks on a charcoal fire and serves a simple meal.

Everything appears to be so ordinary. But that is the secret of God's grace. Jesus appears in the unexpected and ordinary places of our lives.


Here Jesus is our servant, we in turn must imitate him. Here we are his catch of fish, we in turn are sent out to be the fishers for him.

When we understand this, we will know why the early Christians were fascinated with this fish story and why they chose the fish to be the most ancient symbol of Jesus, something so ordinary and so plentiful – just like bread and wine on the altar. God continues to feed us and to help us recognize Jesus through symbols and experiences.
