



# FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

### LET US REJOICE IN THE GIFTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT!

In a certain community there was an atheist. A non-believer to the core, he was not interested in matters churchy. It was a cold and dead church anyway. One day the church building caught fire, and the whole town ran toward it to help extinguish the flames... including the village atheist! Someone hollered out: "Hey, this is something new for you, the first time we've ever seen you running to church!" He replied, "This is the first time I've ever seen the church on fire!"

We see the church on fire today. However, it is not the church building on fire, but the Church – the people are on fire. That is what we see in the second chapter of the Acts of the Apostles. The Church was on fire. Why "fire"? Fire is the symbol of transformation! Fire changes whatever it touches. Fire transformed former fishermen, ex-religious leaders, tax collectors into disciples and apostles.

I have enjoyed praying the Holy Spirit novena this week, focusing on the gifts of the Spirit (wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord). I rejoice the power of God in the Holy Spirit so strongly present in our parish. I give thanks to God for the generosity of your gifts especially for the gift of your faith. The times spent in daily Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, Rosary, Bible Study, Faith Formation Sessions and many gatherings of prayer and praises to the Lord spent by you, are very moving and a blessing.

### Apply now for private school scholarships

Get an average of \$7,000 a year for K-12 education



#### May 3, 2022

ST. PETERSBURG – Families seeking more options in their children's education can now apply for the Florida Tax Credit Scholarship and the Family Empowerment Scholarship for Educational Options on one application through Step Up For Students. Scholarship amounts vary by grade and county but will average about \$7,000.

Families can apply online at <u>www.stepupforstudents.org</u>.

The Florida Tax Credit Scholarship (FTC), which began in 2002, and the Family Empowerment Scholarship for Educational Options (FES-EO), created in 2019, provide learning options for students in grades K-12. Combined this year, they funded over 163,000 students in more than 2,000 private schools statewide.

Dependent children of members of the United States Armed Forces and Florida law enforcement officers may qualify, <u>regardless of household income</u>.

Families who want faith-based education options for their children can choose from one of more than 1,200 faith-based schools in Florida.

"This scholarship gives students the chance to attend the school that is best for them," said Stacy Angier, principal of Abundant Life Christian Academy in Margate, a founding partner school with Step Up. "For the last 20 years, Abundant Life Christian Academy has been fortunate to accept Step Up For Students scholarships and has seen the impact it has had on so many students. With the right environment and necessary support, every student can strive to be their best."

When Karla Collins left a 23-year-career in public schools a decade ago to become head of Victory Christian Academy, she was unfamiliar with the scholarship programs. But she quickly saw the benefits of letting families choose the school that works best for their children.

"I was excited to hear that families could choose a private school for their children if they wanted something different," Collins says. "Step Up For Students has been a positive solution for so many of them! VCA is a family experience because of Step Up."

#### About Step Up For Students

Step Up For Students, a 501c3 nonprofit based in Jacksonville and St. Petersburg, has awarded more than 1.3 million scholarships since it was founded in 2002. Today, Step Up administers four of the state's K-12 scholarship programs: the donor-supported Florida Tax Credit Scholarship (FTC) and the taxpayer-funded Family Empowerment Scholarship for Educational Options (FES-EO), for low- and middle-income students; the Family Empowerment Scholarship for Students with Unique Abilities (FES-UA, formerly Gardiner); the Reading Scholarship for public school students in grades K-5 with low reading test scores; and the Hope Scholarship for bullied students.
