



<u>Upcoming Significant</u> Liturgical Days

Sept. 14: Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross (Mass @ 7PM)

In the 4th century, St. Helena went to Jerusalem in search of the holy places of Christ's life. During an excavation,



workers found three crosses; legend has it that the one on which Jesus died was identified when its touch healed a dying woman. The Church of the Holy Sepulcher was built on that site and dedicated on Sept. 14.

The cross is the instrument of salvation for us Christians. It is not the cruelty of the cross that is exalted on this feast day, but the love of God that was manifested on it.

Sept 15: Memorial of Our Lady of Sorrows (Mass @ 8:30AM)

St. Ambrose saw Mary as a sorrowful yet powerful figure at the cross. Mary stood fearlessly at the cross while others fled. Mary looked on her Son's wounds with pity, but saw in them the salvation of the world.

Mary's strength to persevere in her faith and trust in God even in the darkest of times is great example to us in our Christian journey.

FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

HOPE TO BEGIN ANEW: I guess all of us have had the experience of losing things and finding them. Have you ever lost anything? What happened when you lost whatever was dear to you? You felt frustration, sadness, and worry. You go searching for it.

Today, we learn (Lk 15:1-32) that it is not only sheep and coins that get lost. People get lost too. People of all ages can get lost in many ways. They can get lost morally and spiritually. For every sort of reason

some of them just take off and vanish. People addicted to alcohol or drugs,



people who cannot settle down, people who cannot hold down a job or finish a course of studies, people who are unable to maintain a stable relationship – all of these can be said to be lost.

We all have sometime or other "gone astray" and disobeyed God's commandments. We are surrounded by evils that threaten our very existence. We are also a part of the evil that surrounds us. We multiply our sufferings

through indifference and selfishness. At times we feel afraid, and we realize our own helplessness. But Jesus says: "Have no fear. I have overcome this world". Though we all are sinners we hope in the great mercy of God. Today we are

reminded of God's loving desire to seek us out

when we go astray.

St. Francis de Sales notes that when we stray far from the path of God's love, our Savior never forgets to show that his mercy is above all his works. When our Lord sees a soul plunged into evil, He speeds to its aid. As we consent to God's love that comes to rescue us from our misery, we are like old plants, once deadened by the winter but now growing green and vigorous. We again take on strength and life in the "wine" of heavenly love that cheers the human heart. God's infinite mercy desires that all have life eternal and that none perish. This gives us hope to begin anew.
