FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

ATTITUDE OF GRATITUDE:

Not so long-ago famous people all over the world were polled by a magazine which asked them the question, "If you could be granted one wish that will come true right now – what would that be?" There were some very interesting responses. But one response impressed the magazine's editors so much that they commented on it. That impressive response was this – "I wish that I could be given an even greater ability to appreciate all that I already have."





It is an interesting answer, an interesting thing to wish for. What do you think would happen if each one of us suddenly became a more thankful person? Mothers, fathers, brothers, sisters, spouses, and children would be very happy. No one likes to be taken for granted, all of us like to be appreciated and thanked.

The healing of the ten lepers is the best example of thanksgiving to God. We all have heard the story many times: 'Jesus cleansed ten lepers, but only one cleansed leper

returned to thank Jesus.' Jesus' words are filled with sadness: "Were not all ten made whole? Where are the other nine?" But he turns his attention to the one who has returned to give thanks. He reminds him that faith has been his salvation. "Go your way" and nourish your newfound gift of faith.

Many times, we can be like the lepers in the Gospel. We ask for healing or strength or

grace. Often, we're very aware that God has given us what we need at the time. Luke is asking us: what do you do when you have received your gift? Are you thankful? Do you nourish your newfound gift? Or do you keep returning and asking, never taking the time to be thankful?

It's interesting that Jesus didn't take back the healing he had given to the other nine. God's faithfulness doesn't change. Saint Paul's hymn in his second letter to Timothy reminds us of this truth: "If we have died with Jesus, we shall also live with him; if we hold out to the end, we shall also reign with him. But if we deny him, he will



deny us; if we are unfaithful, he will still remain faithful, for he cannot deny himself."

Let us be thankful; our God is always faithful in caring for us.
