

FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

ENDURANCE: As we approach the end of the Church year, the Scripture readings begin to call our attention to the end-times.



They remind us that Jesus came among us to inaugurate the

kingdom of God. Through the sacrifice he offered on the cross, our sins have been forgiven and we have been reconciled with our Father. We have been given a share in Jesus' new life and that makes us children of the kingdom of God who are journeying home to our Father's house.

Our celebration of the Holy Eucharist allows us to share in the one sacrifice of Jesus, to open ourselves once again to the grace of salvation, to reconcile ourselves more deeply with our Father and with one another, and to be nourished with the bread of life for our continuing journey home.

The word and sacrament we share in the Holy Eucharist can help us to keep our minds and hearts focused on Jesus and his words to us. That focus will enable us



to avoid the agitation and anxiety many people around us experience as we hear talk of the end times. We hear many claims about special revelations concerning the end of the



world. The apocalyptic message of the Scriptures has always raised these kinds of claims. They disturb many good people. Jesus tells us very clearly today: "By patient endurance you will save your lives."

Therefore, we must wait for the coming of the Lord with constancy.

There is no reason for discouragement. We must put our trust in him. Christ is with us; the final victory is his. We must do good without ceasing, for only through endurance we will save our life.

CHURCH FOYER AREA RENOVATION

After 30 years we will be renovating and updating our church Lobby (gathering area), Brides Room, Priest Sacristy, and Restrooms in the brides' room, priest sacristy, and cry room. We will be replacing floors, cabinets, plumbing, and painting walls and ceiling.

The construction has begun on **Monday 11/7** with very little disruption for daily Mass except we will have to use side entrances to enter and exit the church during this week.

There will be no disruption for the weekend masses.

Beginning Monday, 11/14 through Friday, 11/18 daily Mass will be held in the Family Life Center. We will keep you updated weekly. It is our goal to complete the majority of this project by Thanksgiving.

Adoration will be cancelled weeks of 11/14 and 11/21. Adoration will begin again on 11/28.

Togetherness Tuesdays will be cancelled for the month of November and will resume on December 6.






