

SYNOD OF BISHOPS ON SYNODALITY



Prayer for the Success of the Synod

We stand before You, Holy Spirit, as we gather together in Your name. With You alone to guide us, make Yourself at home in our hearts; Teach us the way we must go and how we are to pursue it. We are weak and sinful; do not let us promote disorder. Do not let ignorance lead us down the wrong path nor partiality influence our actions. Let us find in You our unity so that we may journey together to eternal life and not stray from the way of truth and what is right. All this we ask of You, who are at work in every place and time, in the communion of the Father and the Son, forever and ever. Amen.

For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, and Mission.

As we celebrate the opening of the Local Synodal Process on October 17, there are many people who are not aware of this historical time and opportunity within our Church. This process is being conducted in all dioceses of the world in communion with the Bishop of Rome, Pope Francis. It is essentially a synod on synodality which will occur in three phases:

Local Phase (October 17, 2021 - April 15, 2022)

Continental Phase (April - October, 2022)

Universal Phase (October 2022-October 2023)

Each phase will feature discernment sessions and will focus on a series of questions provided by the Vatican. Our local planning committee has discerned to focus on three of these ten questions in order to be able to give proper attention to those three.



WORLD MISSION SUNDAY

World Mission Sunday, organized by the Society for the Propagation of the Faith, is a day set aside for Catholics worldwide to recommit themselves to the Church's missionary activity through prayer and sacrifice. World Mission Sunday will be celebrated within our diocese on Sunday, October 24th, 2021. The offerings that will be collected are destined for a common fund of solidarity distributed, in the Pope's name, by the Society for the Propagation of the Faith among the missions and missionaries of the entire world. 


