



# FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

## LIVE LIFE TO THE FULL:

Today, the Lord asks: "All these things you have prepared whose will they be?"



The book of Ecclesiastes says, "Sometimes one who has toiled with wisdom and knowledge and skill must leave all to be enjoyed by another who did not toil for it."

Ecclesiastes is a part of the Wisdom Literature, which searches for the meaning of life. If you have a tough week, then the Ecclesiastes is the reading for you. Nothing is like a feeling of wonder if all we do is worth doing and getting our attention. "What do mortals get from all the toil and strain with which they labor under the sun? For all their days are full of pain and their work is a vexation; even at night their minds do not rest."

The gospel parable of the rich fool draws our attention to the theme of futility of life. Though written some two thousand years ago, these readings speak to our reality today, and call us to reflect on the vital difference between 'making a living' and 'making a life'.

Making a life means finding the spiritual value in our activities. When we lose the spiritual value of things, we have lost their meaning. They become vanity. Making a living is sometimes vain, but making a life is our vocation.


Well one morning, something like 120 years ago, a man opened the newspapers and he happened to glance at the obituaries.


That was before they started putting photos in the obituaries. He was shocked to see his name in the column. The newspapers had carelessly reported his death in place of his brother who had just passed away.


Anyway, the man continued reading the obituary, and from shock, he became shellshocked. For the first time in his life, he saw himself as others saw him. Because the obituary described him as the "dynamite king" who had spent his life making instruments of death and destruction.

That morning, that man, whose name is Alfred Nobel, resolved to change his image and his life. His resolution resulted in the annual Nobel prizes in physics, chemistry, medicine, literature, and world peace. So, from meaningless death-dealing, Alfred Nobel became a life-giving person, and till today he is remembered for that.

So, when life is over and done, may God nor others not call us "Fool". Rather may we be known as a person who is life-giving, who lived simply and humbly, and was rich in the eyes of God.


