



FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

HANG IN THERE: There is a magazine cartoon that shows a little fellow kneeling beside his bed for his bedtime prayer. He says with some measure of disgust, "Dear God, my dad still doesn't have a job, Grandma is still feeling sick, and I still don't have the iPad I wanted – and I am tired of praying for this family and not getting results."





Probably all of us have felt this way and felt like

quitting. Jesus knew that we would be tempted to quit praying. Therefore, he speaks of perseverance - perseverance in praying. We are encouraged to persevere in our faith in God's goodness by being attentive to God's Word.

Do we believe that God cares enough to listen to us? Do we believe that God answers our prayers, even if it's not always the answer we're expecting? Or do we tend to lose heart after praying a few times?

These days, many lose the sense of and need for prayer. Some substitute work for prayer and say: "Do some social service to your neighbor rather than waste your time praying". Is it necessary to pray? Yes, Jesus himself prayed. Though he never

needed prayer for himself, he prayed and taught his disciples to pray.

The parable of the unjust judge in the Gospel reminds us that we can rely on God even if all our friends forsake us. Even if we must suffer because of faith, we must remain loyal to God. God listens to us always. Therefore, amid all our activities, whether we work or relax, alone or in company, we can live by faith and love, and experience the union with the Lord.

Our prayer must be persistent. If we are faithful, we will make great progress. Saint Francis de Sales says: "Perseverance is the most desirable gift that we can hope for in this life. For this reason, we must continually ask for perseverance by using the means God gives us to obtain it: prayer, helping others, frequenting the



sacraments, associating with good companions, and hearing and reading Holy Scripture."


