

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Dear Friends,

The dictionary defines *transfiguration* as to "transform into something more beautiful or exalted". This is how St. Matthew explains it in today's Gospel. Jesus goes up to the mountain top with his beloved disciples and there he is transformed or transfigured before them. "His face shone like the sun and his clothes became white as light". Jesus is also joined by Moses and Elijah as a

sign that he is the fulfillment of the God's promise of the Old Covenant. Both at the transfiguration and Baptism of the Lord, we hear God speaking from the heaven, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased". But he goes on to say, "Listen to him". Remember that this command is not only for the disciples but also for each of us.

According to St. Francis de Sales, transfiguration of Jesus is seen as a "glimpse of heaven". He says, "our eyes, our minds and our hearts need to be transfigured or transformed in ways that enable us to catch this, "glimpse of heaven", within us and around us. We need to see more clearly the glory of a God who always loves, redeems, heals, forgives, challenges, pursues, strengthens, and inspires us. Let us earnestly pray for the grace to listen to Him and through our exemplary Catholic Christian living to make that "glimpse of heaven" more clearly visible and available to the eyes and in the lives of others.


