

Spiritually Adopt an Unborn Child



Spiritual Adoption Program






Financial Report Fiscal Year Ended June 30, 2023 CHURCH


CHURCH INCOME AND EXPENSE

Income for the church was higher this fiscal year compared to both the budget and to last year. Attendance at mass has been improving and the generosity of our parishioners is greatly appreciated.



Expenses for our Church were considerably higher this year due to a major renovation of several areas in the church. Also, our Property Insurance increased 58.0% this year due to reappraisal of the properties and large increase in premium. These additional expenses were covered with generous donations by several individuals and with our regular operating funds.





FAMILY LIFE CENTER

Donations for the Family Life Center totaled \$125,862 this year including \$56,000 received for the Debt Reduction Campaign in May and June

Expenses for the Center include the mortgage payment of \$5,771 per month and the Property Insurance payment of \$23,000. All other expenses are paid for by the church. Due to pledge payments from the Debt Reduction Campaign and others who have been supporting the FLC all along we were able to make a mortgage reduction payment of \$80,000 in June. The balance of the mortgage loan was \$415,947 at the end of June.

IMPROVEMENTS THIS YEAR

- -Major renovation to front of church including both sacristies and Adoration Chapel. All these areas had original furnishings and never updated (31 years old)
- -Renovation of a school office
- -Replaced (2) church air conditioners
- -Approximate total cost \$190,000



RESPECT LIFE NOTICE

Please see the important message below from the FCCB (Florida Conference of Catholic Bishops) concerning a dangerous petition being solicited for signatures throughout the state of Florida:

Decline to Sign Petitions for Dangerous
Pro-Abortion Ballot Initiative

An extremely grave initiative is underway in Florida that seeks to erase pro-life protections by banning government regulation of abortion in our state constitution. A network of abortion activists are working to gather petition signatures to have a pro-abortion constitutional amendment placed on the statewide ballot in the November 2024 election. In order to do so, they need nearly 900,000 thousand signatures and are working right now in communities across Florida to collect them.

This amendment is deeply concerning because it will allow all abortions to be obtained until viability and includes a broad "health" loophole, essentially allowing abortion on demand up to birth. The amendment would hinder the Florida legislature's ability to protect women and children from abortion. It could also nullify current laws requiring parental consent before minors obtain abortions and a 24-hour waiting period prior to abortions, as well as the 15-week and 6-week abortion laws recently passed by the legislature.

Floridians should not sign the petition. Declining to sign is not impeding the democratic process; it is taking a stand against what would be a terrible state policy. The FCCB is following developments in the initiative process closely and diligently preparing to help defeat it. Continue your prayers for the protection of the unborn and spread the word to your spheres of influence.
