#### Spiritually Adopt an Unborn Child



Those who can shop at the Navy commissary may find other bargains—General Mills cereal has been one of them lately.



# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Dear brothers and sisters,

It's been almost two months since I came to the Holy Spirit. I am slowly getting acclimated here. My interaction and conversation with each one of you has been very uplifting and enriching. I appreciate your faithfulness and generosity for the Church and for our community. But as you know, it takes time to get to know each other. If you have anything to say stop by the office or email me so that I am aware

of it. Let us help one another to continue to build a vibrant and faithful community based on the Gospel values and the Catholic Christian spirituality. But as I observe, there are certain things going around the parish, are not healthy and unbecoming of a follower of Jesus. This is why I am reminded of the words of Jesus as you read:

"Observe what is right, do what is just; for my salvation is about to come, my justice, about to be revealed."

God gives people their due. We are made in the image and likeness of God. To that end, like God, we are also called to be people of justice and to give others their due. Insofar as God calls us to live justly, one of our greatest temptations is to act in an unjust manner, that is, to live with "two hearts".

#### St. Francis de Sales challenges us:

"Be just and equitable in all your actions. Always put yourself in your neighbors' place and them in yours, and then you will live justly. Imagine yourself the seller when you buy and the buyer when you sell and you will sell and buy justly In the end, we lose nothing by living generously, nobly, courteously and with a royal, just, and reasonable heart. Examine your heart frequently to see if it is disposed toward your neighbor as you want your neighbor's heart to be disposed toward you."

Justice must be the hallmark of even the smallest, most mundane dimensions of the lives of all those who wish to follow Jesus, who wish to live a devout life. It is, in truth, about being more fully - and deeply - human.

To the extent that we treat others as we would want them to treat us in the small and ordinary exchanges of everyday life - fairly, reasonably, rightly - we reveal something of God's divine justice. What better way is there for us to give what is due to God, than by giving what is due to one another...and, in the process, to know the blessedness that comes with being single-hearted? So, there is no room for gossip, slander, bringing down someone's reputation, or his or her good name. St. Bernard says, he who slanders, and he who listens to the Slanderer both have the evil intentions in them. One in his tongue and the other in his ear. With a single stroke of his tongue, the slanderer usually commits three murders. He kills his own soul and that of the one who listens to him by a spiritual murder, and he takes away the social life of the man whom he slanders. So, be kind, considerate, compassionate, be sensitive, loving, and gentle to those whom you come across in your journey of faith. May God bless you abundantly!

#### And why not begin today?


















2022-2023 Standardized Testing Comparison Data - School/Province/Diocese

#### **RESPECT LIFE NOTICE**

Please see the important message below from the FCCB (Florida Conference of Catholic Bishops) concerning a dangerous petition being solicited for signatures throughout the state of Florida:

Decline to Sign Petitions for Dangerous
Pro-Abortion Ballot Initiative

An extremely grave initiative is underway in Florida that seeks to erase pro-life protections by banning government regulation of abortion in our state constitution. A network of abortion activists are working to gather petition signatures to have a pro-abortion constitutional amendment placed on the statewide ballot in the November 2024 election. In order to do so, they need nearly 900,000 thousand signatures and are working right now in communities across Florida to collect them.

This amendment is deeply concerning because it will allow all abortions to be obtained until viability and includes a broad "health" loophole, essentially allowing abortion on demand up to birth. The amendment would hinder the Florida legislature's ability to protect women and children from abortion. It could also nullify current laws requiring parental consent before minors obtain abortions and a 24-hour waiting period prior to abortions, as well as the 15-week and 6-week abortion laws recently passed by the legislature.

Floridians should not sign the petition. Declining to sign is not impeding the democratic process; it is taking a stand against what would be a terrible state policy. The FCCB is following developments in the initiative process closely and diligently preparing to help defeat it. Continue your prayers for the protection of the unborn and spread the word to your spheres of influence.
