FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Our Lady of the Rosary

As we celebrate this feast in honor of the Holy Rosary and Our Lady, seek to renew your trust in her intercession, using this powerful spiritual weapon. Every crime, abuse, cruelty, hatred, and evil of any kind is first and foremost a spiritual defect. It is a sin. The greatest remedy for sin is repentance. The greatest method of winning over sinful hearts to repentance is through prayer, and one of the greatest forms of prayer is the Rosary. The Church, in its popes, bishops, and saints, has held up the Rosary throughout the centuries. Countless saints prayed its beads every day, offering a

spiritual bouquet to Our Lady so she could, in turn, lavish the spiritual roses of that bouquet upon the world. It's a great festival of thanksgiving for the signal and countless benefits bestowed on Christendom through the Rosary of Our Blessed Queen.

"The greatest method of praying is to pray the Rosary." St. Francis de Sales

"Fear not, my people!"

On March 4, 1933, Franklin Delano Roosevelt made his nowfamous remark within the context of his first inaugural address as president of the United States of America:

"So, first of all, let me assert my firm belief that the only thing we have to fear is...fear itself — nameless, unreasoning, unjustified terror which paralyzes needed efforts to convert retreat into advance."

Notwithstanding FDR's assertion, one could have easily argued that there was indeed more to fear than fear itself. America was in the grip of a catastrophic economic freefall. Unemployment stood at twenty-five percent! Countless numbers of individuals and families lost their lifesavings overnight. Struggling farmers had no markets in which to sell their yield. Suicides were common; despondency was rampant; hope seemed vanguished.

And the winds of conflict and conflagration that would eventually fan themselves into the Second World War had yet to come!



On the 6th of August 1606, Francis de Sales wrote the following words to St. Jane de Chantal:

"Dear St. Peter, seeing that the storm was raging, was afraid. As soon as he was afraid, he began to sink and to drown, crying out, 'O Lord, save me.' Our Lord caught hold of his hand and said to him, 'O you of little faith, why did you doubt?' Look at this holy apostle; he walks dry foot on the water the waves and winds could not make him sink; but fear of the wind and the waves will make him perish unless his master saves him. Fear is a greater evil than the evil itself." (Selected Letters, Stopp, p. 125)

During our lives, we are sometimes buffeted by winds and waves of all kinds. Some may barely rock the boat; others may threaten our very lives or livelihood! Be it in the face of threats great or small, may God give us the strength to not allow our fear – however appropriate or prudent – to become a greater threat than the threats themselves.

"Dismiss all anxiety and fear from your minds...then will the God of peace be with you."

HOLY SPIRIT CATHOLIC SCHOOL: A BLUE RIBBON SCHOOL

The list of 353 National Blue Ribbon Schools for 2023 was recently released by the U.S. Department of Education. They include 16 schools in the state of Florida and only 1 private school which was Queen of Peace Academy in

Gainesville. They become the 8th school in the Diocese of St. Augustine to achieve this national recognition.

Of the 40 private schools in America to be named Blue Ribbon Schools of Excellence this year, 34 are Catholic schools.

In 2022, there were only 24 private schools in the country that met the criteria for this award and only 2 (not 16) schools in the entire state of Florida. St. John Vianney High School and Holy Spirit School in Jacksonville.


