### Lectio Divina

- 1. Read: Choose a reading from the Bible and read it a few times, leaving room for the Holy Spirit to call your attention to a word or phrase that God wants you to hear.
- **2. Think about:** Think about how the word or phrase connects with your life.
- **3. Pray:** Talk with God in prayer, either silently or in writing.
- **4.** Listen: Rest in God's presence, quieting yourself and listening for God's response to your prayer.
